Realizing from experience the limitations of one and two teacher rural schools, Frank was instrumental in helping in the statewide formation of school administrative districts, particularly in his area. Over the years, Frank was a leader in community organizations, serving as secretary of the Old Town Rotary Club, later as secretary, then president of the Kiwanis Club of Guilford. He was a member of the Guilford United Methodist Church, the Mt. Kineo Lodge No. 109 F & AM of Guilford, and several retirement organizations.

Frank is survived by many caring and devoted friends.
