VASSALBORO — John P. (Jack) Kennedy, 90, known throughout Central Maine as the "Deer Man," died at his home on the Augusta Road Tuesday afternoon after a long illness.

Kennedy, an ardent outdoorsman, had kept a herd of Sika deer as a hobby for 33 years. The animals, smaller than native deer, have been kept an enclosure near his home and have been a popular attraction for both children and adults. Today's herd of 16 are the descendants of the first pair he acquired in 1947, after retiring from Central Maine Power Co. in 1944.

Born in Vassalboro on Nov. 24, 1891, son of John W. and Clara Kennedy, he graduated from Oak Grove School in 1909 and from Colby College in 1913.

He was a member of Neguemkeag Lodge #166 AF and AM for 65 years, 47 of them as treasurer, and was honored two years ago at a testimonial to his long service to masonry. He also served as Master of the Lodge, which is located at Getchell's Corner. He was a member of the Scottish Rite Bodies of Maine and was a 32nd Degree Mason.

He is survived by his widow, the former Thelma Earle; two daughters, Mrs. Maxie (Beatrice) Maltais of Ocean Point and Mrs. Milton (Marion) Walter of Berea, Ohio; one sister, Mrs. Doris Dugier, of Oakland; 11 grandchildren; nine great-grandchildren. A daughter, Patricia Lopez, died July 4, 1981.
