BROOKS — Albert L. Kenney, 64, died Oct. 20, 1994, at a Belfast hospital. He was born in Brooks, June 26, 1930, the son of Leland A. and Alice M. (Pollard) Kenney. He was a 1948 graduate of Morse Memorial High School in Brooks. He graduated from the Maine Maritime Academy in Castine as a marine engineer and served for three years in the Merchant Marines. He was a lieutenant serving on active duty in the U.S. Navy as chief engineer on board the U.S.S. Diamond Head AE-19, an ammunition carrier. He was discharged from active duty in 1955 and continued to serve in the Naval Reserve for several years. He graduated from the University of Maine at Orono in 1961 as a civil engineer. From 1962 to 1970, he was employed by Ingersoll-Rand Company in New York as salesman of heavy duty construction equipment. He returned to Maine and purchased The Kenney Agency, an independent insurance agency located in Unity, which he operated from 1971 to 1984. He then sold his agency and moved his office to his home in Brooks, where he had been employed as a real estate broker, insurance agent and property manager until the present time. He was an active member of and supported many Masonic bodies in the state including the Marsh River Lodge No. 102 AF & AM of Brooks; past master and past district deputy grand master of the 12th Masonic District, serving as treasurer for many years; past high priest of Wal-

do Chapter No. 7 Royal Arch Masons; and past grand captain of the Host. He was a member of the High Priesthood of King Solomon's Council No. 1 R & SM; past illustrious master and member of the Order of the Silver Trowel; past commander of Palestine Commandery No. 14 Knights Templar; an officer of Tamerlane Conclave No. 4, Red Cross of Constantine; a member of the Scottish Rite Bodies, Valley of Rockland A.A.S.R.N.M.J. and past most master; a member of Maine Consistory Scottish Rite; and a member of Anah Temple Shrine A.A.O.N.M.S. of Bangor. He was also a past patron of Josiah H. Drummond Chapter No. 91 Order of the Eastern Star of Thorndike; a member of the Brooks Booster Club for many years and worked in the office of the Annual Fourth of July celebration. He enjoyed golf, gardening, people, animals and scholarly reading. He is survived by his wife of 41 years, Jocelyn (Besse) Kenney of Brooks; three sons, Craig A. Kenney of Sacramento, Calif., Paul A. and daughter-in-law, Brenda Kenney of Brewer, Philip A. and daughter-in-law, Sarah Kenney of Brooks; a daughter, Karen J. Kenney of Boca Grande, Fla.; two brothers and sisters-in-law, Richard M. and Wanda Kenney of Knox, Robert N. and Shirley Kenney of Searsport; five grandchildren, two close cousins and their wives, Seth and Marguerite Knowlton of Rockland, Reuben and Marjorie Kenney of Brooks; several nieces, nephews and cousins. Friends may call 7-9 p.m. Saturday at Rockliffe Funeral Home, 22 Church St., Belfast. Funeral services will be held 2 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 23, 1994, at the Brooks Congregational Church with the Rev.
