MECHANIC FALLS — Roger B. Keough, 57, of North Street, died June 3, 1992, at his home after a brief fight against cancer. He was born in Lewiston, Nov. 1, 1934, the son of Bernard and Teresa Keough. He graduated from Edward Little High School in the Class of 1953 and married Patricia Aaron on Oct. 20, 1972. Mr. Keough was a partner in SMD Metal Fabrication in Mechanic Falls and had been in the metal fabrication business for more than 30 years. He traveled extensively across Maine and New Hampshire and was a familiar face in paper mills and other businesses throughout Maine. He was a member of Ashlar Lodge 105 AF & AM in Auburn for more than 30 years and became Ashlar's youngest master in 1966. He was also a member of the Scottish Rite and the Kora Shrine. He became a member of the Mechanic Falls Town Council in 1972 and served for nine years as council chairman. He organized the Industrial Development Council in Mechanic Falls in 1981 and served as its president for seven years. He also organized the Androscoggin County 4-H Beef Club

and was active in projects involving young people. He enjoyed hunting and fishing and obtained his private pilot's license and flew for several years. He is survived by his wife of Mechanic Falls; his parents of Auburn; one son, Roger B. Keough II of Mechanic Falls; three daughters, Lisa Gellatly of Auburn, Ruth Quirion of Monmouth and Jamie Morrison of Lovell; one brother, Richard of Hebron; and eight grandchildren. Funeral services will be held 2 p.m. Saturday at the Raymond Funeral Home, 5 Dwinal St., Mechanic Falls, with interment in Maple Grove Cemetery, Mechanic Falls. John Kern, 75, Found Local Meat Pack

Heart Attack Victim Was A Native Of Switzerland

John Kern, 75, founder and president of John Kern and Son, local meat packers, died in his home, 901 Washington Avenue, Tuesday afternoon from heart disease. Although he had suffered from the ailment over a period of years he never previously had been seriously stricken. When the attack occurred Tuesday, he was able to call his physician.

Death closed a varied and adventurous career begun at Eglisau, Switzerland in 1863. Before establishing his business here in 1906 Mr. Kern successively served as hotel clerk in Geneva, Switzerland, sailor in the far flung ports of the world; and proprietor of a grocery store at Farmington. He first settled in Portland in 1892 as an employe of the Portland Beef Company.

Not content to prepare for the career of a veterinary prescribed for each son of his family. Mr. Kern left Eglisau for Geneva. After serving as clerk in the Hotel Desbergues there without appeasing his restlessness, he decided to travel. A foot journey across the Alps into Lombardy and to Genoa, Italy, eventually brought him to the busy French port of Marseilles where on March 1, 1881 he shipped aboard a German vessel bound for South America.

He first came to Maine by chance. Stranded in San Francisco where his vessel suddenly was sold, young Kern boarded a ship from Searsport. He stayed with this vessel for several years, later settling at Farmington on the advice of a shipmate.

After serving 13 years with the Portland Beef Company Mr. Kern was appointed U. S. Government meat inspector. During his tenure of office he first began the manufacture of sausages in his home, grinding, stuffing and linking them by hand with the help of his late wife. Eventually he added bologna and pressed ham to his line of manufactures. The business steadily increased and prospered.

He was a member of Deering Lodge, I. O. O. F., of Corner Stone Chapter, O. E. S. and of Deering Grange.

Himself a member of a large family, Mr. Kern is survived by nine children, four sons and five daughters. They are Edward E. who now resides in England, George C., Lillian M., Alice E., Ida E., Grace A. Sthen and Lina Schenchzer, all of Portland, Alfred D. of Auburn, and John H. of Marion, Mass. Nine grandchildren also survive.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Thursday in the Wilde Memorial Chapel. Interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery.


