CMP engineer, active in Wiscasset

WISCASSET — William Irving Kierstead, 83, of Federal Street, a long-time engineer with Central Maine Power, died Sunday at his home.

He grew up in Rockland, Mass., a son of Ashton and Ruth Kierstead, and graduated from Rockland High School in 1933. In 1937, he received his bachelor of science

degree in chemical engineering from the University of Maine at Orono. He also did graduate work at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

Upon graduation, Mr. Kierstead was employed by International Paper in Jay.

In 1941, he went to work for Central Maine Power Company at the Mason Steam Plant in Wiscasset. He served as watch engineer until 1955, when he became plant superintendent.

On Sept. 6, 1941, he

married Ruth Ladd in Milo.

PASSAGES

"He was a very caring husband and father," his wife said. "He was well-respected when he was superintendent of the station. He was very fair in his dealings with people."

She said he enjoyed the challenge of crises that would come along.

"Engineering was his life's work," she said. "He liked the fellowship with the men and their families."

He was involved with the plant from before the time it opened.

Mr. Kierstead retired from the plant in 1970, and became a consulting engineer for Central Maine Power until his retirement in 1975.

He enjoyed golfing and bowling.

He was a past master and 50-year member of the Wiscasset Masonic Lodge and a life member of the Order of the Eastern Star.

He was an active member of the First Congregational Church of Wiscasset, where he was recently honored as a longtime trustee and treasurer. He was also a member of the Wiscasset Fire Society, a social club, of which he was treasurer at the time of his death.

A son, Richard Ashton Kierstead, died in 1989 and a daughter, Lois Kierstead, died in 1998.

Surviving are his wife of 57 years, Ruth Ladd Kierstead of Wiscasset; a sister, Jean Amaya of Shelby, N.C.; a brother, Robert L. of West Roxbury, Mass.; three grandchildren, Laurie Kierstead Skalsky of Tucson, Ariz., Jessica B. Lapid of Chatham, N.J., and Matthew A. Kierstead of San Diego, Calif., and two great-grandchildren.

Laurence "Larry" Lester Kiesman, 84, of Bridgton Rd., Fryeburg died Jan. 21 at Bridgton Hospital. Born August 27, 1920 in Fryeburg, the son of Lester and Eldora (Richardson) Kiesman, Larry graduated from Fryeburg Academy in 1938 and joined the Army Air Corps in 1940. He attended Wentworth Institute and New England Aircraft School in Boston and became an aircraft mechanic.

Larry spent over two years in combat overseas during World War II as an aerial engineer on Troop Carrier aircraft in England, North Africa, Sicily, and Italy flying troops and supplies. In 1944 his plane was shot down over Yugoslavia and ditched into the Adriatic Sea. After a stay in the hospital, Larry came back to the States and married Winnie Hiersche of Ludlow, Mass.

After the war he stayed in the Air Force and made the military a career. Larry served 28 years, retiring as Chief Warrant Officer 4 and having received numerous military decorations including the Silver Star and the Purple Heart. In 1965, during the Viet Nam war, he was assigned as Staff Maintenance Officer and Chief of Maintenance at Don Muang International Airport in Bangkok, Thailand. Larry retired July 31, 1968 as Chief Maintenance Inspector, Air Force Logistics Command. After his retirement he returned to

Saco River.

Larry became the first Building Inspector in Fryeburg and served for six years. He was a Charter member of Fryeburg Rescue and one of the first officers. He also served his community as a Fryeburg Special Police Officer for eight years. Larry was one of the members of the Saco River Environmental Advisory Committee who wrote the legislation for the Saco River Corridor Commission and was Fryeburg's representative to that Commission for 4 years.

In 1978 he was elected State Representative and served for six years in Augusta. Larry was a member of Pythagorean Masonic Lodge and its treasurer for 26 years, a member of the Fryeburg Fish and Game Club, and a trustee of the Mt. Pleasant Cemetery Association. He was a Board Member of the Fryeburg Academy Alumni Association and also served as a member of the Finance Committee and as Treasurer, receiving the Fryeburg Academy Distinguished Alumni Award in 1995. He was a Deputy Fire Warden, a member of Fryeburg Historical Society, and a member of the American Tree Farm Family. Larry was a lifetime member of the Fryeburg Fair and an assistant to the Superintendent of the Forestry Resource Center at Fryeburg Fair.

He and his wife own the land next to Walker's Bridge, allowing the public to use it as a river access at no

time in his childhood hunting, fishing, and canoeing. It was his desire that it always be available as a recreational resource for the public to enjoy and he worked to keep it that way. Larry worked with and supported the Maine Warden Service and the Maine Forestry Department in their efforts to protect the river and the lands adjacent to it so it would remain available for public use. He most recently served on the Town Cable Committee, working on the renewal of Fryeburg's contract with the State Cable Company.

Predeceased by a brother Frederick Kiesman and a sister Dorothy Sargent, surviving family includes his wife of 60 years Winnie (Hiersche) Kiesman of Fryeburg; a son Terry Kiesman and his wife Nancy of Attleboro, MA; a daughter Rebecca Leonard and her husband Scott of Lafayette, CO; grandson Jeremy Kiesman and his wife Natalie of Dallas, GA; granddaughter Alexandra Kiesman of Attleboro, MA; granddaughter Maren Leonard of Lafayette, CO; brother Gerald Kiesman and his wife Ada of Fryeburg, ME; and brother Leonard Kiesman of Fryeburg, ME.

leadman, planner and estimator. His crew installed some of the navigational instruments on the nuclear submarine USS Nautilus, which later went to the North Pole.

In 1964, he transferred to Mare Island Shipyard near San Francisco, where he continued to install navigational systems on nuclear submarines until his retirement in 1977.

Mr. Kilburn worked in a variety of occupations before he settled into work as an installer of

technical systems in nuclear submarines. During the 1950s, he was a partner with his father selling automobile polish.

"It was pretty good polish," said Kenneth Elliott, a lifelong friend. "They made it out of some muck from out of a pond at the back of town."

His father successfully distributed and sold the polish for several years, but Mr. Kilburn left for a job with the U.S. Forestry Department.

During World War II, Mr. Kilburn worked in the West Yard of the New England Shipbuilding Corp. complex in South Portland. After the war, he operated Kilburn Electrical & Plumbing Co.

He was self-made and self-taught," said his daughter-in-law, Cynthia Kilburn. When he inherited the Main Street home which had been in his family since 1860, he built a foundation and added the house's first electricity and indoor plumbing. During the 1947 forest fires, he coordinated the efforts of the fire departments of Cornish and surrounding areas, and was credited with helping organize a firefighting plan that saved the village of Cornish. "They did a very good job," Elliott said. "The fires stopped right at the back of our house. They had about 100 men and four big bulldozers."

After the fires, Mr. Kilburn continued to help build up the fire department, his daughter-in-law said, by redesigning and converting a former airport crash truck into the town's second fire truck. "He was a technical person, not afraid of doing anything," she said.

Born in Washington, D.C., a son of Adelbert M. and Harriet Farnham Kilburn, he attended schools in Albany, N.Y., and Springfield, Mass. He was a member of the Greenleaf Masonic Lodge.

His first wife, Athnea R. Smith Kilburn, died in 1956 and his second wife, Barbara McIntire, died in 1994. He lived in Naples, Calif. from 1977 until returning to Cornish in 1995.

Surviving are two sons, Alan of York and Philip of Cornish; 11 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. A memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. Sunday at the York Funeral Chapel, Maple Street in Cornish. The Rev. Denis Dunn will officiate. Burial will be in Riverside Cemetery, Cornish.
