BANGOR - Dr. Charles H. King, Jr. died March 15, 2001. Dr. King was born in Brewer, May

2, 1917, the son of the late Dr. Charles H. King, Sr. and Sadie (Hall) King.

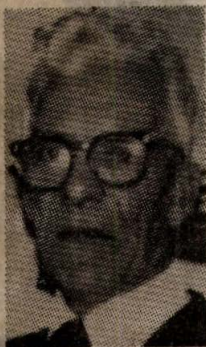

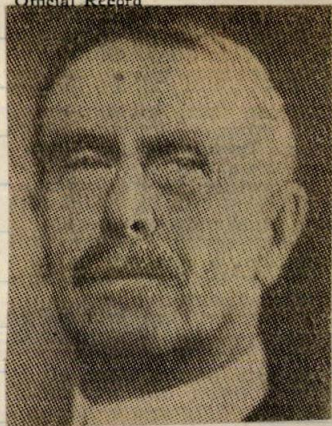

Portland lost one of its most respected and best-liked citizens Saturday when 79-year-old Warren Cloudman King died at his home, 693 Congress Street, after an illness which four years ago forced him to retire from his position with the Portland National Bank. He had been in their employ for 46 years.

One of the City's most faithful residents, Mr. King was born here July 15, 1863. The King family history became entwined with Portland's vital statistics records when his grandfather settled here to raise his family.

Today's is not the Portland that the young Warren King, son of Marquis F. King, former mayor, knew. His earliest childhood recollections were of the great fire on the Fourth of July, in 1866, when his father carried him from the former's photographic studio on Middle Street to their home at 83 Green Street. Their "Green Street" is now Forest Avenue.

Mr. King attended Portland High School and belonged to the school cadets. As a young man, he was engaged in his father's business before accepting a position with the Union Safe Deposit and Trust Company — now known as the First Portland National Bank.

Interested In Photography

He remained, however, an ardent photographic fan and was for several years vice president of the New England Photographers' Association. His photograph collection was considered probably the largest in Maine.

It was on Nov. 14, 1937, that Mr. King and his wife, now deceased, celebrated their golden wedding anniversary, an occasion of considerable publicity for the quiet couple. She was the former Miss Elizabeth T. Pennell of Portland.

Prominent in many fraternal, civic and social orders, Mr. King was a 32nd degree Mason and the only Portland man holding both Masonic jewels for high attainments. A member of Ancient Landmark Lodge for more than half a century, he had served as grand sovereign of the Knights of the Red Cross of Constantine, thrice illustrious master of Portland Council Royal and Select Masters, and high priest of the Greenleaf Chapter of Royal Arch Masons.

In addition, he was a past president of Old Falmouth Chapter, SAR, a past chancellor of the Knights of Pythias and an honorary member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars. Mr. King, during his lifetime, was a member of so many organizations that it is impossible to list all of them.

Injured In Auto Accident

Mr. King came near to death in the Winter of 1935 when he was injured by an automobile which skidded on icy pavements. His condition was considered "only fair" in view of his advanced age at the time.

One of Mr. King's most prized possessions was a large oil painting, My Saint and Angels, which was rescued by his father from the disastrous fire of 1866. It served to remind him of his narrow escape.

Funeral services will be held at 2.30 p. m. Monday from 749 Congress Street. Interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery, Portland.
