LEWISTON — Joseph Koss, 83, died at a nursing home here Saturday.

He was born in Russia, the son of Esther Koss. He was married to Rebecca Barr Dec. 29, 1929.

Mr. Koss was a veteran of World War I. He was a shoe manufacturer in Haverill, Mass. In 1929, he came to Auburn and started the Koss Shoe Manufacturing Co.

He was the founder of the Beth Abraham Synagogue in Auburn and one of the founders of the Jewish Community Center. He was a member of the Beth Jacob Synagogue, the B'nai B'rith, the National Shoe Manufacturers' Association, and 210 (a shoe industry charitable organization).

Mr. Koss was one of the twelve original Brandeis University trustees. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge of Ancient Brothers, the Kora Shrine, the Lewiston-Auburn Federation of the United Jewish Appeal, and a past member of Rotary.

Survivors include his wife of Auburn; two sons, Herbert and Edward, both of Lewiston; a daughter, Mrs. Thelma Holtz of Waban, Mass.; a brother, Jacob of Newburyport, Mass.; two sisters, Mrs. Isabel Wheeler of

Lowell, Mass. and Mrs. Edna Rappaport of Melrose, Mass. and seven grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. today at the Beth Abraham Chapel, Auburn, preceded by prayer at 12:30 p.m. from the Teague-Finley Funeral Home, 391 Elm St. here. Interment will be in Beth Abraham Cemetery, Auburn.

KENNEBUNK - John P. Kotlewski, 88, a resident of Summer St., Kennebunk, died Thursday at the Southern Maine Medical Center in Biddeford after a brief illness. He was the husband of Patricia Littlefield Kotlewski. Mr. Kotlewski was born in Toledo, Ohio, June 23, 1914, a son of Joseph and Martha Kotlewski. He was educated at Saint John's High School, Saint John College and did graduate work at the University of Toledo. He served in the U.S. Air Force in Italy during World War II, as a weather officer and was recalled during the Korean War, when he was attached to the 134th Fighter Squadron, Vermont Air National Guard, Burlington, Vt. Mr. Kotlewski worked at Corning-Components as an anode design engineer, retiring in 1984, when he joined the Littlefield Agency as Treasurer. At the time of his death he was a member of the First Congregational (Unitarian) Parish, a former member of the Webhannet Golf Club and York County Board of Realtors and Webber -Lefebvre Post 74 of the American Legion in Kennebunk. He was a member and Past Master of York Lodge #22 AF & AM, a member and Past high priest of Murray Chapter #33 RAM and member and past illustrious master of Maine Council #7, Royal and Select Masters. He was a member of Maine Council, Order of High priesthood, the Thrice Illustrious masters and the Maine Masters and Wardens Association. He was predeceased by a brother, Lt. Col. Joseph M. Kotlewski, USAF (ret) formerly of Palm Bay, Fla. Simon Kupelian, 67, retired superintendent of the Pownal State School, died this afternoon at the Central Maine General Hospital, Lewiston.

Doctor Kupelian ended his services at the school last May 1 after serving as superintendent since 1938. Doctor Kupelian had served the state for 32 years since 1921, and prior to that had been at Augusta State Hospital.

He was named assistant physician of the Pownal school in 1921 when the institution had about 300 patients. He was named acting superintendent in 1937, and superintendent the following year. At the time of his retirement the school had 1,500 patients.

DOCTOR KUPELIAN was born July 5, 1886 in Tarsus, Armenia, son of Simon V. and Georgia Roobian Kupelian. He received his early education in Armenia, and was graduated in 1909 from St. Paul's American College. Soon after he came to this Country and entered Bangor Theological Seminary. He received a Bachelor of Divinity Degree in 1912. That Fall he entered the former Bowdoin Medical School, graduating in 1916. While at Bowdoin he served summer church parishes.

Doctor Kupelian served his internship at the Maine General Hospital in Portland, following which he was 10 months at the Augusta State Hospital. During World War One he was attached to the Army Medical Corps. Following his discharge, he practiced medicine for one year in Portland, after which he took the post at the Pownal school.

He was a member of the Masonic bodies, including Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston. He was a past commander of Lewiston Commandery; past high priest of Boaz Chapter, RAM, New Gloucester; past patron, Golden Sheaf Chapter, OES; member and past president of the Portland Kiwanis Club, a member of the American Medical Association, Maine Medical Association, Cumberland County Medical Society, Portland Medical Club, and was a fellow of the American Association of Mental Deficiency. He also was a member of Gray Post, AL, Granite Grange of Pownal, and state and national Granges.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Barbara M. Connor Kupelian; two sons, David N. Kupelian, Waltham, Mass., and Philip N. Kupelian, Gray; two brothers, Verne S. Kupelian, Columbus, O., and Ellis S. Kupelian, Belmont, Mass., and two granddaughters.

He recruited students for MCI and was a member of the executive board of the MCI Alumni Association. He served on board of directors and executive committee of the March of Dimes and was a past president of St. Mary's Holy Name Society and a member of the Parish Council, Executive Committee and Finance Committee. He was a past president of the Retired Maine State Police Officers Association and a member of its board of directors.

His Masonic affiliations included: Rising Virtue Lodge No. 10 AF & AM of Bangor and the Scottish Rite Bodies. He was a member of the Bangor-Brewer and Old Town-Orono Shrine Clubs and the Sunshine Club. His enrollment in Anah Temple was recorded as June 13, 1987.#
