His interest in the funeral business began with Giberson Funeral Home of Bingham and he continued his alliance with the Giberson family, including his annual hunting trip to the Bingham area.

He owned and operated Lackee Funeral Home and Ambulance Service from 1957 to 1970 in Bridgton.

Mr. Lackee was president of the Maine Funeral Director Association from 1968 to 1969 and was continually an active member.

He was active in town affairs and often found time to aid in the betterment of the Bridgton community.

He was also an active member of Bridgton Industrial Corp. and served as selectman for the town of Bridgton from 1962 to 1965 and chairman from 1964 to 1965. He was chairman for the Board of Trustees for Northern Cumberland Memorial Hospital in 1968, active member and 1965 grandmaster of Oriental Masonic Lodge 13 of Bridgton and a member of the Bridgton Chamber of Commerce, of which he served as president for a two-year term. He was also an active member of the Bridgton Lions Club and was king lion in 1962.

He moved to California in 1970 and married Claudia Macdonald of San Francisco in 1974. While in California, he worked in the funeral profession and belonged to the veterans of Foreign Wars of San Mateo, Calif.

Upon retirement in 1989, he returned to Maine and lived in South Portland. In his retirement years he was an employee of Hobbs Funeral Home.

He was an active member and president of Westbrook Kiwanis Club. He enjoyed gardening and caring for his fruit trees and took pride in sharing his harvest with neighbors and family.

Surviving are his wife of 25 years, Claudia Lackee of South Portland; two sons, Franklin C. of South Portland and George L. of Norway; two daughters, Grace F. Cleaves of Portland and Virginia C. Ward of Alfred; five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.






