SCARBOROUGH -- Donald E. Larrabee Sr., 75, of Scarborough died Sunday, July 22, 2007, at Maine Medical Center.

Donald was born Sept. 25, 1931, the son of Louis and Marion Wiggins Larrabee. He graduated from Scarborough High School class of 1950. In 1952 he graduated from the University of New Hampshire.

Following college, he joined the United States Army where he served for two years until his honorable discharge. Donald was a two time past master Mason of Governor William King Lodge and Past Patron of the Eastern Star. He was a former deacon of the Black Point Congregational Church in Scarborough, coach for the rotary little league and Cub Scout helper. He was a member of the Scarborough Fire Police and Volunteer fireman of Engine Company One for over 45 years. He was a member of Eastern and Maine Draft Horse Association.

He farmed on the Larrabee Farm for 30 years. He worked for the Maine Turnpike Authority, part time for Webber Oil and retired from Brockway Smith Company in 1995. PRESQUE ISLE - Louis P. Larsson, 82, died Jan. 31, 1999, at his residence. He was born Sept. 14, 1916, in New Sweden, the son of Frank L. and Hulda (Storm) Larsson.

He attended elementary school at Jemtland School in New Sweden, graduated Caribou High School in 1935 and attended Northeastern University in Boston, Mass. He had been employed in a variety of railway capacities for 41 years, retiring as a railway accountant. He was also a local field representative for Barco Federal Credit Union. He retired May 29, 1979. Mr. Larsson was a former member of the Evangelical Covenant Church in New Sweden and current member of the Grant Memorial United Methodist Church in Presque Isle, where he had served as a trustee, financial secretary and treasurer, secretary of the administrative board, and various other committees within the church body. When New Sweden celebrated its One Hundredth Anniversary in 1970, Louis served as co-chairman in planning and promoting a week of events and was honored to portray the 1870 founder of the Northern Maine Swedish Colony, W.W. Thomas Jr. in the pageant that was presented during the celebration. He also chaired the finance committee which raised \$50,000 to restore New Sweden's Historical Museum which was destroyed by fire in 1971.
