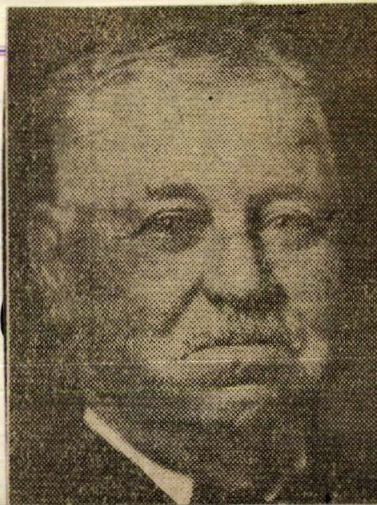

## Kenneth M. Laughton operated inn at Higgins Beach

SCARBOROUGH - Kenneth M. Laughton, 85, a longtime innkeeper at Higgins Beach, died of congestive heart failure Wednesday at his Higgins Beach home.

Mr. Laughton and his wife, Dorothy, went into the summer hotel business in 1954. He had saved his money for 20 years while working at the Saco Lowell Shops in

Biddeford, and purchased the Higgins Inn.

The same families returned each summer for decades for vacations at the large wooden structure, built in 1923 at Higgins Beach.

"They had looked at all kinds of different businesses," said his son, Rodney Laughton - Boys' camps, poultry farms - before he settled here. When they bought the inn, he had no idea how to run it, but he was determined to succeed."

In their first summer season in 1955, a room went for \$3 a night.

Business wasn't great at first, said his son, but it soon prospered thanks to a lot of hard work. For the first few years he hired a chef, but then he learned how to do the cooking himself. He ran the inn as a traditional New England family-oriented resort business, and had many repeat customers from the Montreal area.

### PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

A few years later the Laughtons bought the nearby Breakers hotel, and used it at first for overflow customers. Mr. Laughton was a skilled carpenter, and he built a 40-seat dining room, a commercial kitchen and added a foundation to the Breakers. "He was an industrious man," said his son.

By 1965 the two hotels became too much work for just a small family operation, so the Laughtons sold the Higgins Inn.

A lifelong resident of Scarborough, Mr. Laughton enjoyed recounting the days of his youth.

"He saw a tremendous amount of change in the town," said his son. "He told me that Broadturn Road and Dunstan were impassable in the spring unless you had a horse. It was when the electric trolleys were in their heyday."

Mr. Laughton took a great interest in Scarborough history, and he could easily recount from memory several generations of most of the oldtime Scarborough families, as well as countless birthdays, anniversaries and other events.

"He was the family datekeeper," said his son.

After retiring, Mr. Laughton enjoyed vegetable gardening and beekeeping. He was a 60-year member of the Orchard Masonic Lodge.

Born here, a son of Addison and Olive Webster Laughton, he was a 1931 graduate of Scarborough High School.

His wife, Dorothy Sawyer Laughton, died in 1968, and in recent years he was a close companion of Beulah Brewer.

Surviving are three sons, Norman, Ronald and Rodney, all of Scarborough; a daughter, Louise Mosley of Vidalia, Ga.; eight grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

At Mr. Laughton's request there will be no funeral. A graveside service will be held at 2:30 p.m. Friday at Black Point Cemetery. Arrangements are by Hobbs Funeral Home, South Portland.
