Herbert A. 'Spike' Leonard veteran UMaine agriculturist

ORONO - Herbert A. "Spike" Leonard, 79, died Thursday at Orono Nursing Home after a brief illness.

He was born at Thorndike, son of Arthur and Grace Wing Leonard. He was a 1935 graduate of Maine Central Institute at Pittsfield, received a bachelor of science degree from the University of Maine in 1939, and a master's degree from Cornell University in 1950.

During World War II, Mr. Leonard served in the Army.

After the war, he began a 43-year career with the Cooperative Extension Service and the University of Maine. His work with the Extension included 4-H Club agent, assistant county agent, county agent and assistant dairy specialist.

Mr. Leonard started the National Junior Vegetable Judging contest in Maine, established the first cooperative potato spraying effort outside of Aroostook County, developed labor programs in Oxford County for sweet corn and apples, assisted in the development of artificial breeding units, dairy herd improvement association units and cooperative apple growers and packers unit. He was instrumental in establishing the practice of selective cutting of timber stands and the use of professional foresters. He worked closely with farmers in forming the Maine Breeders Cooperative at Vassalboro.

For 31 years, Mr. Leonard was a resident faculty member of the College of Agriculture and manager of farm operations for the University of Maine. He was an associate professor of animal husbandry and extension dairyman from 1951 to 1962, manager of the College Farm and livestock operation from 1953 to 1962, and

merged and upgraded into one unit the dairy, beef, sheep, hog, horse, poultry and milk processing plant operations.

Mr. Leonard was professor of animal and veterinary sciences from 1962 to 1982, and retired as professor emeritus in 1982.

He was a lifetime member of Phi Kappa Sigma fraternity and served on its Housing Corporation as treasurer for many years.

He served on the UMaine General Alumni Association's board of directors, was a member of UMGAA Executive Committee, served terms as board clerk and treasurer and was a member of the Alumni Association budget committee.

Mr. Leonard was a recipient of the Alumni Association's Block "M" Alumni Activities Award and the Alumni Black Bear Award. In 1986, he received the Pine Tree Emblem Alumni Service Award.

He served the UMaine Class of 1939 as a member of its executive committee. In 1988, he was the recipient of the Golden "M" Award.

He was a master Mason, a member of Unity Masonic Lodge, the Maine Consistory 32 degree of Portland and Anah Temple Shrine, Bangor.

He was a member of the Church of Universal Fellowship in Orono, and served on its board of trustees, was a member of the diaconate and was church treasurer.

He served on the Orono School Board, the Veazie Town Council and appeals board. He was a member and president of the board of directors of Maine Central Institute, a member of the committee that founded the Page Farm and Home Museum at the University of Maine.

He enjoyed his camp at Pushaw Lake, gardening, the outdoors and fishing.

His wife, Eleanor Heald Leonard, and a son, Duane, died previously.

Surviving are a daughter, Charlene Leonard Nordstrom; a son, Colin; a brother, Elmer, six grandsons, and a granddaughter.

A funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Church of Universal Fellowship. Rev. Dr. Roger Plummer will officiate. Arrangements are by Brookings-Smith.

Sidney Lerman, 81, a well-known musician and orchestra leader, died Monday at Maine Medical Center. He lived at Gorham House in Gorham, and before that on Longwood Drive.

The Syd Lerman Orchestra was active on the function circuit from before World War II until Mr. Lerman was well into his 70s. He played the piano and led the big band-style 15-piece orchestra, and also had a smaller band that was on the night club and wedding circuit around Maine for more than 40 years.

He was also a piano teacher whose studio at Monument Square served for many years as the unofficial headquarters for the local musicians union, of which he was the longtime secretary-treasurer.

"I revered the man," said Don Doane, a friend and musician who got his start in Lerman's orchestra. "He was a big promoter of live music. He did more for music in Greater Portland than anyone else I can think of."

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Mr. Lerman would go out of his way to help any musician, Doane said, and as the secretary-treasurer of the union, he tried his best to be fair in handing out jobs.

Mr. Lerman's group was the house band for many summers at the Colony Hotel and the Shawmut Inn, Kennebunkport.

"I was doing lounge work six nights a week," Lerman told a Maine Sunday Telegram reporter in 1988. His band was styled after Glenn Miller, Doane

said, favoring the old big-band favorites such as "Moonlight Serenade" and "In the Mood." "No matter what the request, he would try his darndest to fulfill it," said Doane.

"After I came home from New York, playing with Woody Herman, and started my own band, Syd was my biggest supporter. He was more or less like a proud father."

After serving in the Army in Europe during World War II, he returned to Portland and formed his band. He was in his heyday in the years before rock 'n' roll displaced big band music. Even after that, he was still in demand, but reduced the size of his band from 15 down to about seven, and used just a three- or four-piece combo in the nightclubs.

Born in Portland, a son of Eli and Celia Levine Lerman, he was the oldest of nine children, most of them musical. He graduated in 1935 from Portland High School and received formal musical training at Schillinger House, now Berklee College of Music, Boston.

He was a 33rd-degree Mason, a past master of Brotherhood Lodge, the Scottish Rite and the Kora Temple Shrine, and also served as the organist for Scottish Rite, Grand Lodge and Brotherhood Lodge. He was past president of the Portland Lions Club and a member of Temple Beth El.

His wife, Marion Gitlin Lerman, died in 1989.

Surviving are a son, Elliott of Framingham, Mass.; a daughter, Ellen Ward of Wayland, Mass.; a brother, Melvin of Pembroke Pines, Fla.; five sisters, Shirley Losh of Toronto, Ontario, Eleanor Feinstein and Dorothy Weiss, both of Pembroke Pines, Barbara Simenky of Biddeford and Elaine Ferer of Framingham, Mass.; and three grandsons.
