Harold J. Leavitt, 49, of 30 Froswick Avenue, South Portland, for 23 years employed as a fireman by the Maine Central Railroad, fell dead about 6 a. m. today on the second of two locomotives of the Maine Central's Halifax, N. S., to Boston fast "Gull" train as it was approaching Gardiner.

Officials of the railroad said Leavitt had complained to the engineer that he felt ill and a few minutes later collapsed. Heart failure was given by Dr. George W. Alexander of Gardiner, medical examiner, as the cause of death.

Leavitt, who entered the employ of the railroad July 4, 1918, had been freight locomotive fireman intermittently since he entered

the railroad service, and the locomotive on which he was firing was one used during the Independence Day traffic rush. It was being returned to Boston attached to the Gull rather than separately. The train was delayed 58 minutes at Gardiner.

Born at St. George June 20, 1892, Leavitt received his schooling there, and came to Portland upon entering the railroad's employ. He was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of Portland Lodge, Mt. Vernon Chapter and other branches of the order; and the Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen.

His widow, Mrs. Florence O. Leavitt; two half-sisters, Mrs. Arthur Bowley of Rockland and Mrs. Earl Reiner of Pennsylvania; and a brother, Ralph Spear of Pitman, N. J. survive.




