LOUIS G. LEAKOS

BREWER - Louis G. Leakos, 79, a summer resident of Lucerne-in-Maine, died Sept. 1, 2006, at a Bangor health care facility. He was born in Skowhegan, the son of George and Helen (Smyrnios) Leakos. Louis was a graduate of Skowhegan High School and attended the University of Maine - Farmington. He was a veteran of World War II and served with the 143rd Naval Battalion in the Asiatic-Pacific theater. He was awarded the World War II Victory Medal, American Area Medal, Philippine Liberation Medal and Asiatic-Pacific Medal. Upon discharge, he returned to Bangor where he owned and operated Leakos Market on Center Street. In 1960, he established the IGA Foodliner, one of the first major supermarkets in the greater Bangor-Brewer area. In subsequent years, he owned and operated several supermarkets in Maine and New Hampshire. He also operated the Brewer IGA Coffee Shop for more than 30 years. In recent years, he managed John-ny's Pub in Brewer. Louis was a lifelong member and former president of the board of St. George Greek Orthodox Church. He was a member of St. Andrews Lodge No. 83, AF & AM Anah Shriners, Bangor-Brewer Shrine Club and the Lions Club. Louis was predeceased by his wife, Georgia (Brountas) Leakos. He is survived by and will be greatly missed by his two daughters, Elaine D. Leakos and Penelope Leakos, both of West Roxbury, Mass.; two sons, George L. Leakos and Christopher P. Leakos, both of Brewer; one brother, Steve Leakos of Torrence, Calif.; two grandchildren, Nich-olas G. Leakos and Dianna N. Leakos; sister-in-law, Helen B. some cucumbers and corn," said his wife, Lois Bragdon Leary. "He found a nice potato that he was bringing up for his lunch."

For many years, Mr. Leary operated a 100-acre dairy farm in North Saco near the Saco River. About half the land is a designated tree farm. He stopped dairy farming full time in 1959 when his barn burned down. "Lightning struck and destroyed it," said his wife. "The cows were out to pasture, but he lost all his young stock."

After that he worked many years for L.R. Higgins Co., paving contractors, before starting his own paving business with a partner, Clayton Skillin. He was a co-owner of Leary & Skillin Paving Co. for 10 years.

"He never advertised," said his wife. "His good work and honesty advertised for him."

Mr. Leary began collecting milk bottles many years ago, after a friend gave him some with names and logos of old dairies from the area. "He kept trying to add to them," said his wife. "He had about 60 milk bottles."

"His goal was to try to get bottles from all the old-time dairies from around the Saco and Scarborough area," said his daughter, Kathleen Young.

Mr. Leary also had a large collection of postcards from Scarborough and Saco.

After retiring several years ago, he raised sheep and Hereford beef cattle as a hobby.

"He thoroughly enjoyed his animals," said his daughter. "He loved the simple things, such as watching his animals grow. He was always looking forward to the new ones being born in the spring."

For the past few years Mr. Leary worked part time as a driver for Portland Volvo in South Portland.

Born in Scarborough, a son of Clifford and Doris Merrill Leary, he was a 1942 graduate of Scarborough High School.

He was a member of the Scarborough Masons, the Gorham Odd Fellows and the West Scarborough United Methodist Church. During his retirement he enjoyed traveling.

Surviving are his wife of 47 years, Lois Bragdon Leary of Saco; a son, William of Naples; a daughter, Kathleen Young of Saco; two sisters, Letita Huff of Milford, Mass., and Gertrude Mitchell of Scarborough; and three grandchildren.

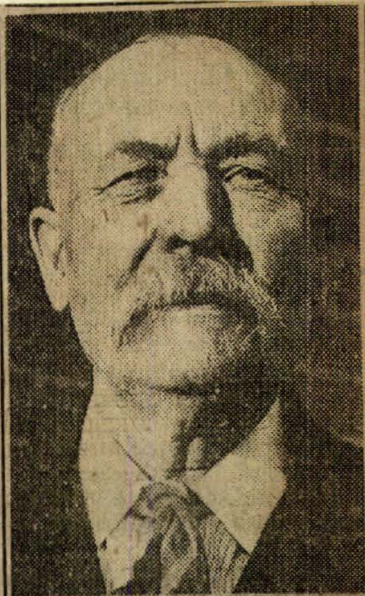

Mr. Leavitt took pride in his military service and was commander on three occasions of the Smith-Tobey American Legion Post. Before breaking his hip two years ago, he marched every year in the city's Memorial Day Parade.

"He was proudest of the year he and another World War I veteran were color guards for Gov. (Sumner) Sewall," said his daughter. Sewall was governor from 1940-44.

"Every time I went out with a fellow that was in the Navy, my father always told them how you should hang your hammock," said Mrs. Horrridge. "Of course, hammocks were a thing of the past by then."



After the war, Mr. Leavitt attended Ferris Institute in Cedar Rapids, Mich. He married Beatrice M. Moore in 1916 in Detroit. He worked in a Dodge plant in Detroit until 1933, when the Depression forced the plant to close. He then moved to Bath and was a route salesman for Oakhurst Dairy and the former Cushman Baling Co.

During his retirement, he was a handyman for several elderly women in his neighborhood, shoveling snow, cleaning ovens, painting and making repairs.

"He did anything these ladies wanted done, for \$4 an hour," said his daughter. "He scrubbed floors and fixed steps. He made it possible for 12 or so women to stay in their homes."

Also during his retirement, Mr. Leavitt was active at Bath Senior Citizen Center on Floral Street.

"He was my right-hand man," said Reid Perkins, president of the senior center. "He was the first there in the morning and the last to leave. He was in his late 80s, and he put us all to shame."

For about 25 years, he was the custodian at the former Winter Street Congregational Church and also was superintendent of the Sunday school and a Boy Scout leader. He was a member of Corliss Street Baptist Church. He was active in the Bath Lions, the Coasters and the Masons of Island Falls.

Born in Crystal, a son of Frank L. and Edna Hussey Leavitt, he attended schools in Island Falls. He enjoyed hunting and always kept a big garden at his home at 125 Congress Ave.

Surviving are his wife of 69 years; a son, William G. of Rochester, N.Y.; a daughter, Gloria Horrridge of Bath; three half brothers, Ralph, Herbert and Earl Leavitt, all of East Hartford, Conn.; nine grandchildren; 12 great-grandchildren; and a great-great grandchild.

A daughter, Holly Fiorette, died in 1980, and a son, Dr. Dean E. Leavitt, died in 1989.
