Kennebunk, June 20.—Arthur Lamont Leech, 65, died suddenly at his home Friday evening. He was born May 28, 1888, Monmouth, son of the Rev. Alfred and Eva Cutter Leech. A prominent Kennebunk businessman, he was a past commander of the Webber-Lafeyvre Post, AL, a past grand chef-de-guerre of the Charles A. Perry Voiture 40 and 8; past master of the York Lodge, AF & AM; past high priest of Murray Chapter, RAM; past thrice illustrious master of the Maine Council, RSM; a member of St. Armand's Commandery, and past chancellor commander of the Marthe Lodge, K of P. He was proxy to the Grand Lodge of Masons for 29 consecutive years, town moderator for Kennebunk for 24 years, a member of the Kennebunk Methodist Church, and a veteran of World War One. Besides his widow, he is survived by two sons, Dr. Alfred L. Leech, Oneonta, N. Y., and A. Wesley Leech of Kennebunk; an adopted daughter, Mrs. Ruth Groneng, Kennebunk; two brothers, the Rev. Henry E. Leech, Hemet, Calif., and Dr. Clifton B. Leech, Barrington, R. I., eight grandchildren, and several nieces, nephews, and cousins. Funeral services will be at 2 p. m. Tuesday from the Methodist Church, the Rev. C. William Landis officiating. Interment will be in Hope Cemetery, Kennebunk.

KENNEBUNK - A. Wesley Leech, 81, Kennebunk's first police chief and longtime operator of Leech Convalescent Home here, died Wednesday at St. Andre's Health Care facility in Biddeford after a long illness.

Mr. Leech took his first position with the town in 1932, when he was appointed a constable. He also served the town at various times as selectman, deputy sheriff, truant officer and town-meeting moderator. He was a volunteer fireman for 49 years.

During World War II, Mr. Leech was a guard in a South Portland shipyard. It was then that town fathers decided to form a one-man police force and asked him to be the police chief.

Born in Newfield, a son of Arthur Lamont and Affie Hardy Leech, he graduated from Kennebunk High School.

Mr. Leech managed a First National Store in Old Orchard Beach for a few years before going to work for 15 years at the R.T. Cole Hardware Store.

"He used to lay linoleum and do other odd jobs for the store," his daughter said. An avid baseball

A. Wesley Leech fan, Mr. Leech was a coach for many years for Knights of Pythias youth baseball teams.

During his retirement he cooked and delivered doughnuts for Congdon's Doughnut Shop in Wells, which is owned by his son, Richard Leech.

He enjoyed hunting and fishing in the Chesuncook Lake area.

Mr. Leech was a 59-year member and past master of York Lodge of Masons, a member of the Maine Council of Saco, St. Amand Commandery, a life member of Royal Arch Masons, a member of Myrtle Lodge of Knights of Pythias, a past president of Western Maine Jubilee Association, Nomads of Abradoka, and a member of the Knights of Khorassan.

He was a member of Christ Church, the York County Law Enforcement Association and Maine State Nursing Home Association.

His wife, Gladys McConnell Leech, died in 1980.

Survivors include a son, Richard of Wells; his daughter, Judith of Kennebunk; 10 grandchildren, 23 great-grandchildren and a great-great-granddaughter.

A funeral will be held at 1:30 p.m. Saturday in Christ Church, Dane Street. The Rev. E. Lamar Robinson will officiate. Burial will be in Hope Cemetery. Arrangements are by Bibber Memorial Chapel.

Funeral of George E. Lefavor, 81, who for 67 years was connected with local newspapers or job printing shops, and who died after a day's illness Thursday, will be at 1 p. m. Saturday at 17 Myrtle Street with interment in Evergreen Cemetery.

He was stricken with a heart attack Wednesday while delivering job printing material on Pine Street. Taken home, he failed rapidly and died Thursday noon.

Mr. Lefavor was born in Boston, Jan. 5, 1859, and died one month before his 82nd birthday. When seven years of age he came to Portland with his parents and attended local schools. As a young man he learned the printer's trade under his father, George H. Lefavor, then foreman of the composing room of the old Portland Daily Press. He remained with that paper 18 years, when he resigned to become foreman of the composing room of the Portland Evening Express, then printed at 88 Exchange Street. After five years he resigned to accept a similar position with the Portland Sunday Telegram, then owned by the late George Bagley. He learned to operate the linotype on the first machine of its kind installed in this City.

In 1902, Mr. Lefavor engaged in the job printing business with his brother, Walter, who in 1905 went to California to own and edit a newspaper. From 1905 to 1915, partnership continued with the late Fred L. Tower as the Lefavor-Tower Company, and in the latter year Mr. Lefavor withdrew and in 1920 joined Smith & Sale, local printers. He conducted a printing shop at 1 Exchange Street from 1920 for four years, then taking as partner, William B. Bradford, doing business as the Lefavor-Bradford Company, and being a partner in the Lefavor, Laughlin Company until six years ago. Since 1934 he had conducted the Lefavor Press at 51 Exchange Street.

He was a member of Atlantic Lodge, AF&AM, Hadattah Lodge, IOOF, Ivanhoe Lodge, K. of P., the Portland Provident Association, the Animal Rescue League and the South Portland Kiwanis Club.

A member of the First Universalist Church, Congress Square, in his earlier life, he transferred to the Church of the Messiah, where he was treasurer and also served in other offices until 1923, when he resumed membership in Congress Square Church.

June 13, 1883, Mr. Lefavor married Miss Eleanor H. Goodhue of this City, and they observed their 57th wedding anniversary this year.

Surviving besides his widow are a daughter, Mrs. Edith L. Blake of South Portland, and a brother, Willis, of Los Angeles.

Mr. Leibowitz began the 28 Monument Square business in October 1946 as a temporary outlet for war surplus goods at reasonable prices. It caught on, however, and he expanded to sporting goods and outdoor gear of all types. By 1950 there were outlets in Bangor, Waterville, Lewiston, Biddeford and Berlin, N.H.

In the 1960s, the Portland store's porcelainized aluminum and glass sign served as a beacon to downtown shoppers. By the 1980s, he was back to just the Portland store.

"To the very end, he deliberately kept some Army surplus goods to keep in touch with the store's roots," said his friend, state Rep. Herbert Adams.

"His three loves were fishing, travel and quiet philanthropy, mostly for young people," said Adams. "I have friends he put through college. 'I never hurt anybody making this money, so it shouldn't hurt me to give it away,' he'd say."

Mr. Leibowitz was a major benefactor to the Maine Caribou Transplant Corp., which attempted unsuccessfully to reintroduce the woodland caribou to northern Maine. "The experiment didn't prove it couldn't be done. It only proved it would be very expensive," he said, according to Adams.

Born in New York City, a son of Frank and Lena Leibowitz, he attended schools there. He was a sergeant in the Army during World War II.

A master Mason in the Portland lodge, he served in numerous Scottish Rite and Masonry bodies. He was a member of the Kora Temple in Lewiston, the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine and the Woodfords Club.

His wife, Marguerite Morin Leibowitz, died in 1969.

Surviving him are two brothers, Harold and Isadore, both of Augusta; and three sisters, Goldie Rosenblatt and Dore Zamkoff, both of West Palm Beach, Fla., and Pauline Ayeroff of Desert Hot Springs, Calif.
