Abraham Leibowitz, owner and president of the Surplus Store for 44 years, died Thursday at a local hospital after a brief illness. He was 82 and lived at 58 Chadwick St.

Mr. Leibowitz began the 28 Monument Square business in October 1946 as a temporary outlet for war surplus goods at reasonable prices. It caught on, however, and he expanded to sporting goods and outdoor gear of all types. By 1950 there were outlets in Bangor, Waterville, Lewiston, Biddeford and Berlin, N.H.

In the 1960s, the Portland store's porcelainized aluminum and glass sign served as a beacon to downtown shoppers. By the 1980s, he was back to just the Portland store.

"To the very end, he deliberately kept some Army surplus goods to keep in touch with the store's roots," said his friend, state Rep. Herbert Adams.

"His three loves were fishing, travel and quiet philanthropy, mostly for young people," said Adams. "I have friends he put through college. 'I never hurt anybody making this money, so it shouldn't hurt me to give it away,' he'd say."

Mr. Leibowitz was a major benefactor to the Maine Caribou Transplant Corp., which attempted unsuccessfully to reintroduce the woodland caribou to northern Maine. "The experiment didn't prove it couldn't be done. It only proved it would be very expensive," he said, according to Adams.

Born in New York City, a son of Frank and Lena Leibowitz, he attended schools there. He was a sergeant in the Army during World War II.

A master Mason in the Portland lodge, he served in numerous Scottish Rite and Masonry bodies. He was a member of the Kora Temple in Lewiston, the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine and the Woodfords Club.

His wife, Marguerite Morin Leibowitz, died in 1969. Surviving him are two brothers, Harold and Isadore, both of Augusta; and three sisters, Goldie Rosenblatt and Dore Zamkoff, both of West Palm Beach, Fla., and Pauline Ayeroff of Desert Hot Springs, Calif.
