FAIRFIELD — Benjamin M. Leighton Sr., 95, passed away Wednesday, Nov. 19, 2003, at Oak Grove Living & Rehabilitation Center in Waterville after a brief illness.

He was born Nov. 8, 1908, in Waterville, the son of George B. and Elizabeth Manley Leighton. He graduated from Waterville High School and was a resident of Fairfield.

He was married to the former Ola Dale. On Oct. 25, 2003, they celebrated their 73rd wedding anniversary. He was employed by Farrar-Brown for 30 years, retiring in 1974; then worked for George Doyle and N.H. Bragg & Sons for the next 20 years.

He was captain of the 1928 Waterville High School state champion hockey team, member of the 1929 Waterville Pro Hockey team, and played hockey and baseball until 1936 for local teams. He joined the Fairfield Fire Department in 1943, became fire chief in 1962, and retired in 1978. He was President of the Maine Fire Chiefs Association in 1969 and received the State of Maine Fireman's Association Award; was president of the Fairfield History House 1997-1998; was a 50-year member of the Fairfield Masons, Shriners and Fairfield 68 Lodge of Oddfellows.

He was honored by the Waterville Rotary Club in 1998 with the Paul Harris Fellowship award for community service. Benjamin was on the Board of Trustees of the Kennebec Valley Community College for several years. Kennebec Valley Community College named a ball field in his honor. He was a long-standing member

of the Kennebec Valley Community College Advisory Council. He served on the first building committee that resulted in locating the campus in Fairfield. He served on numerous committees thereafter.

Survivors include his wife, Ola Leighton; two sons, Benjamin M. Leighton Jr. of Lewes, Del., and Wesley D. Leighton and wife Helen of Holden; one daughter, Norma E. Giroux and husband Paul of Fairfield; three granddaughters, Michelle Danders of Alexandria, Va., Lynne Leighton of Clinton, and Diann Giroux of Higgins Beach, Scarborough; two grandsons, Benjamin M. Leighton III of Alexandria and Peter Leighton of Rockwood; as well as six great-grandchildren.

Benjamin was predeceased by two brothers, Lemuel D. Leighton of Waterville and G. Byron Leighton of Oakland; three sisters, Ethel Leighton, Hannah Strout, and Aloma Leighton, all of Waterville; several nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 25, at the Fairfield Community Center, 61 Water St., Fairfield, officiated by the Rev. Frank Twombly, chief chaplain of the Maine Fire Chiefs.

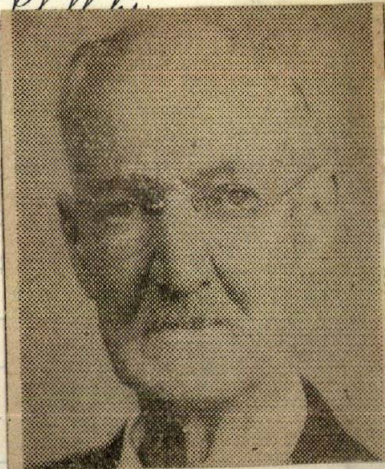

Westbrook, March 3.—Charles H. Leighton, 91, oldest member of the Knights of Pythias in Maine and possibly in the United States, died early today in his home at 417 Warren Avenue.

Born here, Nov. 20, 1858, son of Alvin and Hannah Sawyer Leighton, he was believed to be Westbrook's oldest native. Mr. Leighton was honored last month by several fraternal organizations in observance of his 70th year as a member of the Knights of Pythias. He is a past chancellor of Presumpscot Valley, K of P, and was for many years the prelate of the local group.

Mr. Leighton was a charter member and oldest past noble grand of Ammoncongion Lodge, IOOF, and was a life member of that lodge and the Warren Phillips Lodge, AF&AM and Liberty Encampment, IOOF.

He also was deacon emeritus of the local Advent Christian Church, and was its oldest member. Mr. Leighton, who was retired from the S. D. Warren Company where he was employed for 53 years, was a member of the Westbrook Fire Department 50 years until his retirement nearly 18 years ago. He served on the school committee and was constable for many years in Ward 1. Mr. Leighton first voted in 1880, when he cast a ballot for President Garfield.

Mr. Leighton married the former Lucy Vanner of Westbrook, Sept. 6, 1881, at Eastport, where his wife was born, and they celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary in 1941. Their only son, Leslie S. Leighton, died several years ago. He is survived by three grandsons, Dwight W. Leighton, a student at the Kirksville School of Osteopathy, Kirksville, Mo., Philip S. and Neal L. Leighton, both of Westbrook; a granddaughter, Mrs. Mary E. Timm, South Portland, and four great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 2.30 p. m. Monday in the Advent Christian Church. Interment will be in Saccarappa Cemetery.

Clarence Howard Leighton, 77, a retired Maine telephone company employe for 37 years, died in a St. Petersburg, Fla., hospital Christmas Day after an illness of many months according to word received here Saturday.

Leighton, who formerly resided at 42 Upland Avenue, Portland, retired from the employ of the New England Telephone & Telegraph Company here in 1933. He started with the Vinalhaven Telephone Company and later was manager of Eastern Telephone Company, Farmington, and went from there to Rockland.

He was manager of Knox County Telephone Company, Norway, until the Maine Telephone Company was formed in 1906. He then assumed superintendency of construction work with headquarters at Livermore Falls.

He was superintendent of Ossipee Valley Telephone Company, Cornish, and also served as the company's general manager in New Hampshire and Cumberland County. He held the same position after it was taken over by N. E. Telephone & Telegraph Company. He was transferred to Portland in 1923.

Leighton, former secretary-treasurer of the John M. Keller Chapter, Telephone Pioneers of America, moved to Florida from Portland nine years ago. He spent 13 years as a sailor, and was a member of Knights of Pythias, Modern Woodmen, Greenleaf Lodge of Masons at Cornish and Mirror Lake Shuffleboard Club.

He is survived by a daughter, Miss Florence Leighton, St. Petersburg, Fla., and a sister, Mrs. Grace Jordan, Rockland.

"He was the first special agent in the intelligence division to be stationed in Maine," said Lawrence Gaudreau, an IRS co-worker. "He worked in Maine but was out of the Boston office. They later set up an office in Maine."

"Our work was on criminal violations of the internal revenue code," said Kenneth Dorr, another IRS co-worker. "Primarily income tax fraud and other violations. We only worked on major criminal cases. Other departments han-

dled things such as audits."

"He started out in the old Post Office on Middle Street," said his wife, Belle Leighton. "Then they moved to Cumberland Avenue, and after he left the department, they went to Forest Avenue."

In later years, Mr. Leighton was a coin collector, specializing in proof coins, which are minted annually especially for collectors.

While in Florida, he was a treasurer for four years for the Venice United Church of Christ. "Figures and finances were what he was interested in," Mrs. Leighton said.

Mr. Leighton retired to Venice 24 years ago from Portland but spent summers at his camp on Highland Lake in Windham.

Born in Westbrook, Maine, a son of Arthur and Marcia Libby Leighton, he graduated from Portland High School in 1926 and also took courses through the Treasury Department.

He was a member of the Masons, Woodfords Club and Order of the Eastern Star, all of Portland.
