Sumner C. Leighton, 76, of Yarmouth was killed instantly and two others escaped a similar fate Wednesday afternoon when two heavily loaded trucks crashed at Cumberland Foreside, blocking the Portland-Yarmouth highway for four hours.

Leighton, operator for 54 years of an express trucking business between Portland and Yarmouth, died from fractures of the skull and chest and compound fractures of the left leg and arm, Medical Examiner William Holt said.
