

## Harrison E. Lemont

KITTERY Maine Harrison Edward Lemont. 84, died Friday, Aug. 10, 2007, at York Hospital following a period of failing health.

Born Oct. 10, 1922, in Norwich, Conn., he was a son of Walter P. and Regina L. (Lambert) Lemont, Hegraduated from Robert W. Traip Academy, Class of 1942, and received a college degree in accounting.


