## Theodore Everett Lewin

### Army general, civic leader

ALGUSTA - Brig. Gen. Theodore Everett Lewin, 94, of Augusta died Friday at the Kennebec Long Term Care Home on Glenridge Drive in Augusta, where he had lived for about a month.

Born in Danforth, a son of Edwin Lewin and Elizabeth Holmes Lewin, he lived in Augusta most of his adult life except for periods of active duty military service.

Mr. Lewin was active in the community, including participation in local and state government and local civic organizations.

During the 1920s and 1930s, he had worked as the produce manager for an A & P store in Rockland, for Augusta Hardware and for the Central Maine Power Co. As did many during the Depression years, he worked other jobs, including selling men's hosiery door to door and picking apples at harvest time. During this time he joined the State Guard.

In 1928 he served as Scoutmaster for Augusta Troop 1.

In late 1940, he went on active duty as a second lieutenant. During World War II, he served as a Signal Corps officer in Fort Monmouth, N.J., Camp Benning, Ga., and Camp Murphy, Fla. Overseas, he participated in the campaigns in Sicily and Italy.

After the war, he returned to Augusta and worked on the Maine Adjutant General's staff. In 1950 he was assigned to the staff of the National Guard Bureau at the Pentagon in Washington, D.C., and also served as military aide to then Gov. Burton M. Cross during activities associated with the 1953 inauguration of President Dwight Eisenhower.

Later, he assisted the Adjutant General as U.S. Purchasing and Fiscal Officer. He retired from the military in 1962 as a brigadier general, and became involved in local and state government. He served on the Augusta Planning Board, several terms on the Augusta City Council, and four in the Legislature from Augusta.

Gen. Lewin was a member of Rotary International, he served as Augusta president and governor of Rotary District 779. He raised funds for the Augusta Rotary's annual sale of fruit cakes, and later Vidalia onions. The Augusta Rotary honored him in a meeting in August 1991.

He also headed the Cony PTA, the Augusta Salvation

Army Advisory Board, Augusta Red Cross Chapter, the Odd Fellows, Kennebec Valley 4-H, committees for the governor's inaugural ball and prayer breakfast, and served as moderator of the Penney Memorial Baptist Church. He was associate director of International Christian Leadership in Washington, D.C., Maine Chapter commander of the Military Order of World Wars and vice president of the Maine Society in Washington, D.C.

Gen. Lewin was a member of the Windsor Fair board, Friends of Lithgow Library, Maine Association of Retirees, American Legion and VFW, Augusta General Hospital Associates, Kennebec Valley United Way board, Kennebec Valley Girl Scout Council, the Masons and Kora Temple Shrine, and Midstate Cerebral Palsy Chapter. He also participated as a counselor for Boys' State.

He has been an active member of the Penney Memorial Baptist Church since 1927.

His first wife, Florida Cooke Lewin, died in 1981.

Survivors include his wife, Pauline Frost Lewin; a sister, Helen L. Turner of Chelsea; two daughters, Cynthia L. Hennessey of Jefferson and Sylvia L. Morris of Crofton, Md.; a son, retired Rear Adm. Theodore Edwin Lewin of Alexandria, Va.; five grandchildren and three great grandsons.

A funeral service will be held at 1 p.m. Wednesday the Penney Memorial Church on Grove Street. Arrangements are by the Knowlton and Hewins Funeral Home, 1 Church St.

Capt. Benjamin West Lewis, Jr., 73, died Tuesday morning, May 31 at St. Andrews Hospital after a brief illness.

Born July 8, 1920 in Boothbay Harbor, he was the son of Benjamin W. Sr. and Beatrice (Locke) Lewis.

Capt. Lewis graduated from the Maine Maritime Academy in the second class in 1943 and served in the Merchant Marines for many years, retiring in 1985. In World War II he served on the dangerous convoy duty carrying arms to Murmansk, Russia. At one time he was one of the youngest men to hold an unlimited Master's license, being in his twenties. During the Vietnam War he was Master of the S.S. American Condor carrying supplies to Saigon. On one of those trips his chief mate was his childhood friend, Bert Rowe, also of Boothbay Harbor.

He was a member of the Marine Society of the City of New York, an honorary organization of Sea Captains founded by George Washington.

In between trips to sea Ben, an ardent fisherman, bought his first charter boat in 1949 and was instrumental in starting the Boothbay Harbor Tuna Club, which still holds an annual tournament. In 1971 he purchased the 36-ft. Capella which he ran with his old friend and veteran mate Howard Brewer.

After retiring from the sea he resided at his home in Boothbay Harbor.

Surviving is his wife of 49 years, Katherine McFetridge Lewis; two sons, Terry Lewis of Boothbay Harbor, the first son of a graduate to graduate from Maine Maritime Academy and, owns an antique shop in Wiscasset, and Jeremy Lewis, an artist, of Phoenix, Arizona, and a brother, Judge Eben H. Lewis of Anchorage, Alaska.
