

George Lindsten, 89, died Nov. 12, 1984, at a Caribou nursing home where he had been a resident since 1980. After a period of refurbishing, the Stuga is now located behind New Sweden Historical Museum as a historical remembrance. He was married to the late Lillian Erickson Dec. 7, 1940. He was employed for many years by the Pratt Whitney Co. of Hartford, Conn., and the Norton Co. of Worcester as a draftsman. In later years he was employed at Loring Air Force Base as a

He was also a member of Lodge No. 170, AF & AM, of Caribou and the I.O.O.F. Lodge of Caribou. He is survived by one sister, Miss Annie C. Lindsten of Westmanland. Linnell Rites To Be Tomorrow

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. tomorrow at the State Street Congregational Church for William S. Linnell, 82, prominent local business man and attorney, who died yesterday in a local hospital after a brief illness.

Mr. Linnell, who lived at 81 Brighton Ave., entered the hospital two weeks ago after suffering a stroke.

A SENIOR PARTNER in the law firm of Linnell, Perkins, Thompson, Hinckley and Thaxter, he had been associated with the firm continuously since 1934.

He was born in Biddeford, July 21, 1885, son of William Franklin and Sarah Shepherd Linnell, and was graduated from Thornton Academy in Saco. A graduate of Bowdoin College in 1907, Mr. Linnell earned his law degree in 1911 from George Washington University and was admitted to practice before the Maine bar the same year.

His wife, the former Jesse E. Hopkinson of Saco, whom he married in 1912, died in 1958.

Actively interested in the progress of the city, he was a longtime member of the Greater Portland Chamber of Commerce. As its president in 1960 he urged the community to look realistically at its resources and to "follow a vision of the kind of central city we would like this area to have, and go after it"

MR. LINNELL served as president and a director of the Portland Gas Light Co., from 1927 until 1963, when he re-

signed from the presidency, but remained on the board of directors. He was also on the board of directors of the Bancroft and Martin Corp., and a director of the National Bank of Commerce.

Active in the Republican Party, he was chairman of the Republican City Committee from 1919-1921; a member of the state Republican Committee from 1923 until 1934; a national committeeman from 1937 to 1938. He served on the Governor's Council from 1925 to 1928.

His numerous memberships in clubs and organizations included Saco Lodge of Masons; Mount Vernon Chapter, RAM; Portland Commandery, Knights Templar; Portland Council, R. S. & M.; and the Maine Conclave, Knights of the Red Cross of Constantine.

He was a member of the Kora Temple Shrine, Lewiston; the Portland Shrine Club, a 32nd Degree Mason; and a past district governor of the Rotary Club.

Mr. Linnell also held memberships in the Woodfords Club, Portland Club, Cumberland Club and the Torch Club. He attended the State Street Congregational Church.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Shelton C. Noyes, Rangeley, and Mrs. Casper F. Cowan, Portland; a son, Robert S. Linnell, Las Vegas, Nev.; eight grandchildren; and two sisters, Bertha R. Linnell and Adelaide R. Linnell, both of Portland.
