James Henry Littlefield were held in the Congregational Church, Wednesday afternoon by Fraternal Lodge of Masons. The funeral sermon was preached by the Rev. G. Elmer Mossman of the Scarboro Congregational Church, formerly of Alfred, and the Masonic service was conducted by the Rev. Charles L. Stevens, chaplain. All officers of Fraternal Lodge attended and Fern Chapter, O. E. S., was present in a body. Mr. Littlefield was not only a charter member of Fern Chapter but he and his wife were its first worthy patron and worthy matron. He was also a past master of Fraternal Lodge F. And A. M. and a past district deputy grand master in the 23rd District.

Mr. Littlefield was born in Kennebunk, March 10, 1845, the son of Abiel and Maria Littlefield and came to Alfred to live upon his marriage to Miss Fannie S. Knights of this place. They had one son, Ernest F., who died at the age of 14 years. Mrs. Littlefield passed away three years ago, so that Mr. Littlefield is survived only by three nieces, Mrs. Mary Taylor and Mrs. Lulu Junkins of Kennebunk and Mrs. Harriet Hallett of Boston.

For many years he conducted a grist mill and later a saw mill at Littlefield's Mills at the lower end of the town. He was a member of the Methodist Church and the last one of the group of people who more than half a century ago were active in the work of the church that was torn down a few years ago after being sold to the county. He had held in the principal town officers including those of selectman, treasurer, and tax collector and for many years had been looked upon as one of the town's leading citizens.

The body was entombed at Evergreen Cemetery.

SCARBOROUGH — Judge Ray L. Littlefield, 42, died Monday at the home of his granddaughter on Herbert Drive. 1-30-88

He graduated from Massachusetts Agricultural College, Amherst, Mass., and the Palmer College of Chiropractic, Davenport, Iowa, in 1922.

Lacking a formal legal training, Judge Littlefield was appointed a trial justice in 1939 and trained himself during the 28 years that he served in that position. He was appointed to four seven-year terms by Maine governors, retiring in 1967 after having heard well over 20,000 cases.

Judge Littlefield heard all of his cases in the front room of his Route 1 home, retiring when the state replaced the old trial justice and municipal court system with the present district court system.

During his lifetime he had been a fire and automobile insurance agent and a licensed real estate broker. He was a former director and vice president of the Kaler Vaill Memorial Nursing Home and a former director of the Black Point Cemetery Association.

From 1939 until 1956 he served as tax collector for Scarborough.

He was a past president of the South Portland Kiwanis Club.



He was a 32nd degree Mason, a member and past master of the Old Orchard Beach Masons, a charter member of the Governor William King Masonic Lodge, a past most excellent master of the York Royal Arch Chapter, a past illustrious master of Maine Council, R & SM, Saco. He was also a past district deputy grand master of the 18th Masonic District, a charter member and past patron of the Miniwanca Chapter OES, Old Orchard Beach, and a past master of the Oak Hill Grange.

He served as treasurer of the Cumberland County Republican Committee for 23 years.

Judge Littlefield was a past chancellor and a 67-year member of the Nonesuch Lodge of the Knights of Pythias, a former member of the Scarborough Volunteer Fire Department and an organizer and former president of the Scarborough Rotary Club, where he received the Paul Harris Award.

He was a member and deacon of the First Congregational Church of Black Point and served for 12 years as superintendent of its church school.

Born in Rochester, N.H., he was a son of Frank and Emma Richards Littlefield, and moved to Maine as a child. He attended Lyman and Alfred schools and had lived in Scarborough since 1912.

He married Cora B. Hudson in 1915. She died in 1948.

His second wife, Martha Effie Littlefield, died in 1966.

Surviving are his wife of 18 years, Lillian Littlefield of Scarborough; three daughters, Mildred Nowell and Alva Wiley, both of Scarborough, and Marilyn Hughes
