





William Locke

William Locke, former traveling freight agent, died on May 28, 1938, at the age of 78. He had retired in March 1932, with a service record of more than 50 years. He first entered the employ of the Maine Central Railroad in 1881 as a station agent at Fryeburg, his home town. He came to Portland in 1890 as clerk in the freight traffic department and up to the time of his retirement had held various positions including traveling agent, special agent, superintendent heater car service, and traveling freight agent. He was well liked and had an exceptionally wide acquaintance all over the Maine Central system.

Funeral services were held in the Congregational Church in Fryeburg May 31 and burial was in the family lot in that town under Masonic auspices. A delegation from the Maine Central general offices in Portland attended in a body.
