Capt. Bert S. Look, 71, retired shipmaster, and long associated with his brother, Capt. Oscar Look in extensive blueberry land holdings, timberland and the silver black fox business, died Thursday, Aug. 5, at his home in Jonesport.

In his sea-faring days, Captain Look commanded many well known sailing crafts, among them the F. G. French and his last vessel being the Frank W. Benedict, which he himself had built.

He long took an active interest in town affairs, had served as a member of the School Board and was a member of the present high school building committee.

He had served 27 years as treasurer of Jonesport Lodge, F. and A. M., was also a member of Washington Chapter and St. Elmo Commandery of Machias and Morocco Temple, Mystic Shrine, which he joined in Jacksonville, Fla.

Mr. Look was born in Jonesport, May 7, 1866, the son of the late Willard and Electa Look. In 1889 he married Minnie Reed of Boothbay Harbor.

JONESBORO — Carroll F. Look, 75, a lifelong resident of Jonesboro, died Feb. 2, 1990, at a Bangor hospital, after a short illness. He was born in Jonesboro, the son of Harvey M. and Charlotte (Farnsworth) Look. He was a member of Howard Lodge No. 94 AF & AM, Machias; a past patron of Machias Chapter No. 83 OES; a past master of Jonesboro Grange No. 357; a former trustee of Jonesboro Union Church; and a member of the board of corporators of the Downeast Community Hospital. He served many years as a Jonesboro town official, having been a selectman, clerk, treasurer and tax collector. He was also a director of the West Penobscot Telephone Co. He was an ardent aviation enthusiast and helped to pioneer active aviation in the downeast area, being one of the original members of the Machias Valley Airport Committee and one who was largely responsible for obtaining state and federal funds for its original development. He, with his brother Daniel, conducted a construction business for 46 years in the area, which is now being carried on by his son, Timothy. He is survived by his beloved wife, Thelma (Fish) Look; four sons, Bruce L. and Timothy C. of Jonesport, Dean F. of North Waterboro and Tony R. of Chelso; seven grandchildren, one great-granddaughter; his only sister, Affie M. Carlson of Jonesboro, as well as several cousins, nieces and nephews. Dean Everett William Lord, educator and lay preacher who died last night.

Dean Lord was 93 years old. He died in the Osteopathic Hospital of Maine after several days' critical illness.

HE WAS BORN in Surry Jan. 31, 1871, son of Capt. Samuel Lee Lord and Mary Phoebe Wood Lord. As a boy he shipped aboard the tern schooner Mary Lord, a family venture commanded by his father, and made many coastwise and several foreign trips as cook of the vessel.

At 18, rather old for a freshman, he forsook the sea and enrolled at Ellsworth High School, from which he was graduated in 1891. He taught for a time in a one-room school and then returned to Ellsworth High as submaster.

In 1893 he was appointed superintendent of Ellsworth schools, one of the youngest men in the nation to head such a system.

In 1896, however, Mr. Lord enrolled in the liberal arts course at Boston University to begin an association with that institution which lasted for nearly 69 years. He received his bachelor of arts degree from BU as a major in Spanish in 1900 and his master of arts degree there in 1906.
