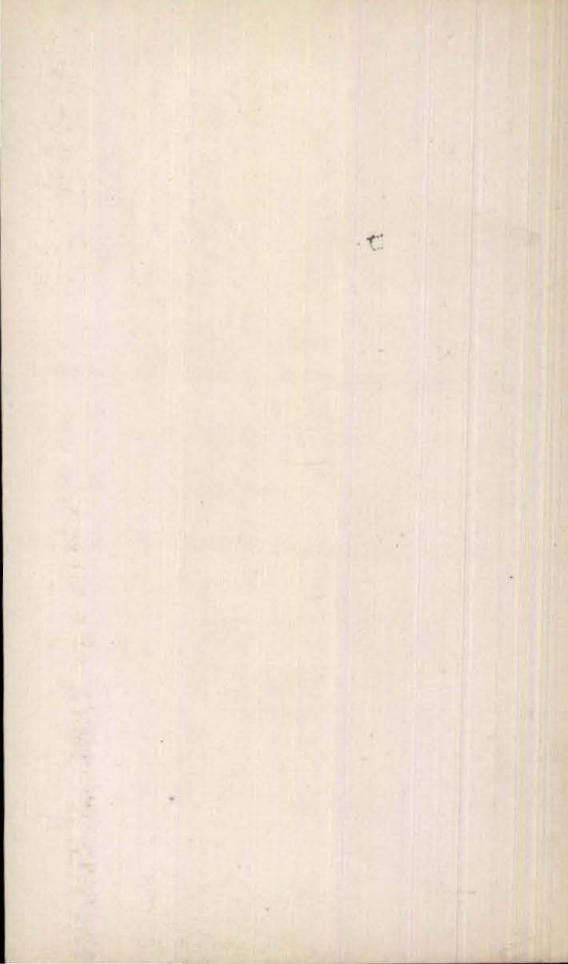

He was born in Auburn, a son of Charles Parker and Ethel Miller Loring, and attended Auburn schools. He graduated from Edward Little High School and Bowdoin College, Brunswick, in the class of 1931, where he was a member of the Theta Delta Chi Fraternity.

In the early 1930s Mr. Loring began Loring, the Printer, a Lewiston company that he owned and operated.

He was a pilot, a 2nd lieutenant in the Civil Air Patrol and was active in anti-submarine patrols along the coast of Maine.

While in Rhode Island he established a business called C. Parker Loring, Bank Stationer, and moved that business and his family to the Portland area in 1964.

He was a former member of the Lewiston Rotary, the Masons, the Portland Commandery and Kora Temple Shrine.

Mr. Loring was a member of the Casco Bay Power Squadron and the Portland Yacht Club.

His wife of 55 years, Florrie Wright Loring, died in 1988.

Surviving are a daughter, Constance Loring; a son, William W., both of Yarmouth; a brother, William N. of Farmington; and six grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held for Mr. Loring and his wife at 4 p.m. Friday, May 19 at their residence. The Rev. Audrey McGinnis will officiate. Arrangements are by Conroy-Tully Funeral Home, Portland.

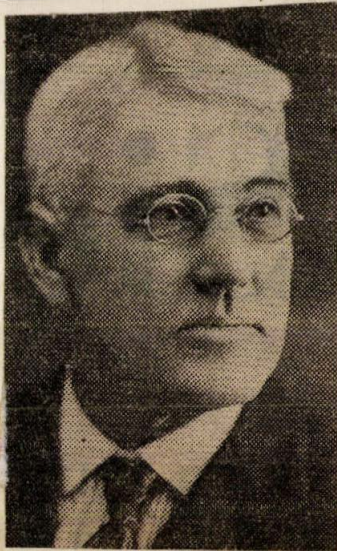
