GEORGETOWN — Wilbur F. Loveitt, 79, of Loveitt Lane died unexpectedly on Sunday, June 3, 2007, at Central Maine Medical Center in Lewiston.

He was born in Georgetown on March 14, 1928, a son of Ellsworth B. and Adaline B. (Mains) Loveitt.

He served in the U.S. Army Air Force from April 1946 to April 1949.

On June 19, 1952, he married Ethel M. Richardson and they have resided in the same home he was born in. He was employed at Bath Iron Works for 40 years, retiring in 1991 as a manufacturing engineer.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church in Bath, where he was a past trustee for many years and involved in the men's club. He was a life member and past master of the Polar Star Lodge of Masons No. 114 in Bath, serving as secretary for 42 years. He had recently received his 50-year medal. He was a member of the Solar Lodge of Masons No. 14 in Bath, the Trinity Lodge of Masons in Augusta, and the Montgomery St. Bernard R.A. Chapter No. 2 in Bath, where he was past high priest and past grand high priest of Maine.

He was a member of the advisory board of Demolay for many years, on the advisory board for Rainbow Girls, member of the Kora Shrine Temple in Lewiston, a member of the Genesta Chapter No. 73 of the Order of the Eastern Star and the Amaranth, and was also active in many other Masonic positions. He was a life member of the Bath Lodge of Elks No. 934, the Bath Area Senior Citizens, the West Bath Grange and the State Grange, the National Rifle Association, and a member of the Hyde Windlass Rifle Club, where he shot a perfect score of 200 during a competition.

He was selectman of Arrowsic for 26 years, also town constable and school board member for many years in Arrowsic.

He enjoyed spending time with his family and grandchildren, and hunting, fishing and lobstering with his brother Herbert.

He was predeceased by one son, William Ellsworth Loveitt, in 1955; two brothers, George Loveitt and Harold Loveitt; and three sisters, Hattie Loveitt, Althea Loveitt Heffron and Effie Loveitt Markley.

Surviving are his wife, Ethel M. Loveitt of Georgetown; two daughters, Debra Loveitt Wardle of New Jersey and Sharon Loveitt Guethle and her husband, Jeffery, of Georgetown; one brother, Herbert Ellsworth Loveitt of Bath; two sisters-in-law, Edna Loveitt of Bath and Gertrude Loveitt of Florida; four grandchildren; and many nieces, nephews and cousins.

## Delmar B. Lovejoy

scientist, musician, farmer

WESTBROOK - Delmar B. "Dellie" Lovejoy, 89, a research scientist for S.D. Warren Co., a musician and a farmer, died Monday at a Portland nursing home.

Mr. Lovejoy moved to Westbrook in 1945 to work as a research scientist for S.D. Warren Co. Much of his work involved testing paper samples. After 25 years he retired in 1969 after reaching the then-mandatory retirement age of 65.

After that he worked on his 30-acre farm at 164 Pride St. "He was really a young man at 65, and was fortunate that he had something to do," said his wife, Charlotte Stuart Lovejoy.

Born in Portland, a son of Frank H. and Emma Boynton Lovejoy, he graduated from Mexico High School.

He received an agronomy degree in 1928 from the University of Maine. In college he was a champion pole vaulter on the track team, a member of Alpha Gamma Rho fraternity, and was the leader of the ROTC band.

After graduating from UMaine he worked in the experiment station on the Orono campus. He worked first in the college dairy and later was manager of the Aroostook State Farm in Presque Isle. There he experimented with potato seeds and studied plant diseases in the potatoes.

After that he worked in soil survey for the college, surveying and mapping types of soils throughout Maine. "That's where he met me, when he was in York County," said his wife, a Hollis native.

Mr. Lovejoy studied during the winter at the University of Wisconsin and received a master of science degree in 1935.

All his adult life he studied glacial geology and as a hobby he used to collect rock and soil samples while traveling. "He'd say 'I've got to stop and take a sample there,'" said his wife. "He loved the out-of-doors, forestry and rocks and soils."

He was a member of the Masons of Orono.

Surviving are his wife of 55 years, of Westbrook; a son, Laurence S. of Westbrook; a daughter, Carol Gay of Bellefonte, Pa.; a brother, Kenneth C. of North Port, Fla.; and a grandson.

For 30 years, Mr. Lovering ran the small filling station and repair garage at the corner of Veranda and Sherwood streets. He retired in about 1980.

Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

In 1939 he and a partner began operation of the new Esso station.

"The war broke out, and gasoline got real tight, so he ended up driving city buses," said his son, Bernard Lovering.

After the war Mr. Lovering operated a gas station nearby, on the East Deering side of old Tukey's Bridge. When that station was razed in about 1950 to build the new bridge, he once again took over the Esso station.

"He was a hard worker," said his wife,

Velma Welch Lovering. "At first he operated it alone from 6 in the morning until 11 at night."

"The first summer or two, it was still Route 1," said his son. "You can't believe the amount of gas he sold."

By the time Route 1 traffic was diverted away from Veranda Street, Mr. Lovering had an established loyal following in the neighborhood. The business changed to more of a full-service garage, and he specialized in mechanical work. One of his regular customers was former Gov. Percival P. Baxter.

"Those were the days when father demanded all windshields were washed and oil was checked," said his son. "In the later years, he had his customers trained to pump their own gas."

Mr. Lovering had helped many young men in the East Deering neighborhood learn to be mechanics. "He'd give them a job, teach them some auto mechanics, and keep them off the streets," said his son. "Some of them still

work in the field."

Mr. Lovering worked 15 years as a bus driver for Portland Coach Co., now called The Metro. For most of those years, he continued to run the station.

Although blind for the past several years, Mr. Lovering continued to work at his hobby of woodworking.

"He would do it by feel," his wife said. "He made little flower carts and wheelbarrows."

Born in South Paris, a son of Josiah and Eva Field Lovering, he attended schools in South Paris and Portland, including Portland High School.

He was a 32nd degree Mason and a past master of Cornerstone Lodge. He was also a member of the Scottish Rite, the Kora Temple Shrine, and a 51-year member of the Amalgamated Transit Workers Union.

He enjoyed vegetable and flower gardening, and was a member of St. Peter's Episcopal Church.

Surviving are his wife, Velma Welch Lovering of Portland; two sons, Bruce of Poland, and Bernard of Standish; a sister, Elva Wilson of Scarborough; six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

A funeral will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday at the Jones, Rich & Hutchins Funeral Home, 199 Woodford St. Burial will be at Brookdown Memorial Park.
