CLINTON — Worth L. (Jack) Low, 71, of Clinton died Friday morning unexpectedly at the Veterans' Hospital at Togus following several months gallant struggle against cancer.

He was born in Yarmouth on Nov. 24, 1925, the youngest child of Arlon W. and Emma B. Low. He received his education in the elementary schools of Benton and Clinton and graduated from Lawrence High School in 1943.

Immediately upon his graduation, he joined the Navy. Both of his brothers were already in the service and he wrested permission from his mother to enlist at the age of 17. He was assigned as Seaman Second Class to the ill-fated U.S.S. Benjamin Franklin but was fortunate in being transferred only days before that ship met its terrible fate at the hands of a kamikaze bomber. After several months in a naval hospital, he received a medical discharge and was on his way home, a veteran, not vet 19, on VI Day.

As a young man, he worked as a spare brakeman for Maine Central Railroad, a job he enjoyed because of its variety and challenge. Because of the dangers of the job, he left the railroad to accept the job of herdsman at the Good Will Farm. He later served as herdsman at the Women's Reformatory in Skowhegan before buying a small farm in Madison.

At a time of economic necessity, he was able to get work as an ordinary seaman ("very ordinary" was his wry description) for the Military Sea Transport Company and worked for that firm for a number of years, retiring because of ill health in 1975. During his employment at sea, he worked and studied his way up the job ladder, qualifying in turn for licenses at AB, 3rd Mate, 2nd Mate, and 1st Mate. He was proud of these licenses, not easily attained and was proud of saying that he retired "with a 1st mate's ticket, good in any waters."

He was a member of the Masons and the Oddfellows and enjoyed these affiliations. He was everybody's friend and would go to any lengths to help anyone who needed assistance. He will be much missed by people who relied on his assistance.

Survivors include his children: Martha Vogt and her husband Bill and children Michael and Michelle of Augusta, John of Madison and his wife Jill and daughter Justine, David Low of Richmond, Va., Daniel Low and his wife Jean and their children Mathew and Christopher of Fairfield; his sister, Arlene Low of Farmington; a sister-in-law, Rita Low; a nephew, Stephen Low; and many, many friends.



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



Eugene H. Lowe, 59, representativeelect to the Legislature and for many years engaged in the lumber business at Gray, died suddenly at his home in that town Thursday night from heart disease. 

Mr. Lowe was a former director of Depositors Trust Co., Morse Memorial and MSAD 3 board member, a member of Inter-Agency Crivl Service Examiners, the Governor's Maine Commission on Aging, the Maine Poultry Improvement Association and was an incorporator of Waldo County General Hospital.

 He received many awards including the United States Superior Service Award. Many other awards are listed in Who's Who in America 1971-72. 1972-73.

He was a 59-year member and past master of Marsh Masonic River Lodge and a 51-year member of the Anah

Temple Shrine in Bangor.

Mr. Lowe was a member of Harvest Home Grange.

Brooks Congregational Church and a charter member of
Brooks Lions Club later the Brooks Booster Club. He
and his wife, Iris, received the Brooks Booster Club
Outstanding Citizens Award in 1978.





He was born Sept. 12, 1911, in Lee, the youngest son of Charles A. and Jane Standish (Nute) Lowell. Mr. Lowell was, for many years, active in Unity's town government as well as civic organizations including the Masonic Order; a charter member of the Unity Fire Department; one of the organizers of the Unity Civic Improvement Association: and for many years a principle on the Finance and Property Committees of the Unity Union Church. He is survived by his wife, Caroline Lowell of Unity; two sons, David Alton Lowell of Dallas, Texas, and Charles Frederick Lowell of Boston, Mass.; several nieces and nephews. 



cial Travelers for more than 50 years.


Mr. Lowell was a member of St. Paul's Anglo-Catholic Church on Congress Street.
