WEST BATH — Percy R. Low, 87, died Friday at his home at Birch Point. He had made his home here since 1983.

Born in Bath, he was a son of Charles C. and Annie Ridley Low, and was a graduate from Morse High School in 1916, and Bowdoin College, where he was a member of Psi Epsilon Fraternity, in 1920.

Following graduation he and his roommate, Henry C. Davies of California, set out on a walking tour of over a year's duration. They went across the United States into Canada, Alaska, Mexico and by boat to Hawaii.

He worked for a brokerage firm in Boston for several years and later joined his father, Charles C. Low, who was treasurer of the Bath Savings Institution, in the bank. He later joined the Postal Service where he remained until his retirement in 1965.

Upon his retirement he was cited for his contributions as a multi-lingual employee who helped facilitate communication with the public.

An Army veteran of World War I, he was a life member of the Masons, and a former member of other community and fraternal organizations. He was an avid stamp collector and opera lover.

Surviving are his wife, Isa Wishart Low, a daughter, Ellen L. Doran, and two grandsons, all of West Bath. A memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. Tuesday at the David E. Desmond Funeral Home, 638 High Street, Bath.

BENTON — Robert M. Low, 72, of Benton, died Saturday, July 15, 1995 at a Waterville hospital after a courageous battle with ill health for a number of years.

Educated in the Benton, Clinton and Fairfield school system, he graduated from the University of Maine in 1951 with a B.S. Degree in Agricultural Engineering.

A World War II veteran, he served three years in the U.S. Navy, holding the rank of QM 2/C. He served sea duty on the U.S.S. Cowell, a destroyer of the Admiral Nimitz Fleet in the Pacific Theater.

Robert's work record includes the Maine Central Railroad, New Holland Co. out of Vermont, and he also owned and operated a hardware store in Unity. He was involved in the Agricultural Stabilization & Conservation Services, Military Sea Transportation Service, General Hardware Store employment and served 14 years with the state of Maine as Quality Control Agent for the Department of Human Services. During his retirement, he owned and operated Bedrock Enterprises Greenhouse in Benton.

CLINTON — Worth L. (Jack) Low, 71, of Clinton died Friday morning unexpectedly at the Veterans' Hospital at Togus following several months gallant struggle against cancer.

He was born in Yarmouth on Nov. 24, 1925, the youngest child of Arlon W. and Emma B. Low. He received his education in the elementary schools of Benton and Clinton and graduated from Lawrence High School in 1943.

Immediately upon his graduation, he joined the Navy. Both of his brothers were already in the service and he wrested permission from his mother to enlist at the age of 17. He was assigned as Seaman Second Class to the ill-fated U.S.S. Benjamin Franklin but was fortunate in being transferred only days before that ship met its terrible fate at the hands of a kamikaze bomber. After several months in a naval hospital, he received a medical discharge and was on his way home, a veteran, not yet 19, on VJ Day.

As a young man, he worked as a spare brakeman for Maine Central Railroad, a job he enjoyed because of its variety and challenge. Because of the dangers of the job, he left the railroad to accept the job of herdsman at the Good Will Farm. He later served as herdsman at the Women's Reformatory in Skowhegan before buying a small farm in Madison.

At a time of economic necessity, he was able to get work as an ordinary seaman ("very ordinary" was his wry description) for the Military Sea Transport Company and worked for that firm for a number of years, retiring because of ill health in 1975. During his employment at sea, he worked and studied his way up the job ladder, qualifying in turn for licenses at AB, 3rd Mate, 2nd Mate, and 1st Mate. He was proud of these licenses, not easily attained and was proud of saying that he retired "with a 1st mate's ticket, good in any waters."

He was a member of the Masons and the Oddfellows and enjoyed these affiliations. He was everybody's friend and would go to any lengths to help anyone who needed assistance. He will be much missed by people who relied on his assistance.

Survivors include his children: Martha Vogt and her husband Bill and children Michael and Michelle of Augusta, John of Madison and his wife Jill and daughter Justine, David Low of Richmond, Va., Daniel Low and his wife Jean and their children Mathew and Christopher of Fairfield; his sister, Arlene Low of Farmington; a sister-in-law, Rita Low; a nephew, Stephen Low; and many, many friends.

Visiting hours will be from 2 to 4 and 6 to 8 p.m. on Sunday, Oct. 5, at the Lawry Brothers Funeral Home, 107 Main St., Fairfield.

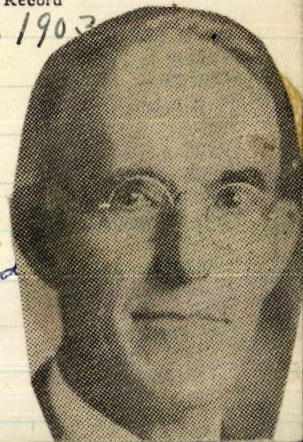

BROOKS - Henry F. Lowe, 79, a longtime government employee and agricultural expert, died Oct. 4 in Zephyrhills, Fla.

Born here, son of Albert J. and Ruth Quimby Lowe, he grew up on a small farm and graduated as valedictorian from Morse Memorial High School in 1934. He graduated from the University of Maine in 1938.

Mr. Lowe worked for the Farm Security Administration as an assistant county supervisor, then worked for Maine Potato Growers as a farm supply manager.

Mr. Lowe was a former director of Depositors Trust Co., Morse Memorial and MSAD 3 board member, a member of Inter-Agency Civil Service Examiners, the Governor's Maine Commission on Aging, the Maine Poultry Improvement Association and was an incorporator of Waldo County General Hospital.

He received many awards including the United States Superior Service Award. Many other awards are listed in Who's Who in America 1971-72, 1972-73.

He was a 59-year member and past master of Marsh Masonic River Lodge and a 51-year member of the Anah Temple Shrine in Bangor.

Mr. Lowe was a member of Harvest Home Grange, Brooks Congregational Church and a charter member of Brooks Lions Club later the Brooks Booster Club. He and his wife, Iris, received the Brooks Booster Club Outstanding Citizens Award in 1978.

He was a charter member of the Links at Lake Bernadette in Zephyrhills, a lifetime member of the Royal Nairobi (Kenya) Golf Course and a member of the Country View Golf Course.

He was a longtime friend of Sheldon Ward.

Surviving are his wife of 59 years, Iris A. Lowe; a son, Albert of Brooks; two daughters, Sharon Eldridge of Brooks and Barrie Fernald of Troy; two sisters, Mary Parker and Shirley Roberts, both of Brooks; 10 grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren.

Paying tribute to Dr. Lowe on the 50th anniversary of his ordination, Dr. Robert Cummins of Boston said:

"The Universalist Church of today was put on its own two feet organizationally and started off in the right direction by John Smith Lowe."

Dr. Cummins, a successor to Dr. Lowe as general superintendent, made his remarks at Rock-

land at the Immanuel Church. He received 18 years' service as pastor emeritus.

In retirement, Dr. Lowe continued to serve as summer pastor of the Little Brown Church in Round Pond, where he had a summer home many years, and as supply pastor in various Maine churches. He hadn't missed a Round Pond service in 24 summers.

Dr. Lowe was a past president of Rockland Rotary Club, a 32nd degree Mason, a member of Phi Sigma Kappa honorary fraternity, treasurer of the Rockland Film Council and unofficial chaplain here of Alcoholics Anonymous.

He received the honorary degree of doctor of divinity from Lombard College, Galesburg, Ill., in 1919 at the conclusion of the million-dollar campaign he led.

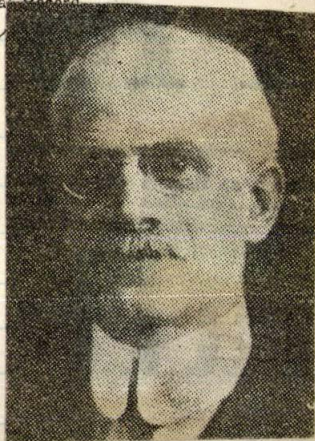

Gorham, Jan. 20.—Abner Waldo Lowell, 85, of 99 South Street, for many years widely-known stationer in Portland up to 1916, when he sold his business and came to this town to reside, died Monday night after a brief illness.

In connection with his business in Portland Mr. Lowell established the first travel and information bureau in that city, the slogan, "Ask Mr. Lowell, he knows," becoming known to the traveling public visiting Portland from many points.

Born in Portland Oct. 19, 1862, the son of the late Abner and Ann Cox Powell, he received his schooling there. His father was the first jeweler in that city, and the son learned the engraving business under him and conducted an engraving and stationery business for 33 years. He was located on Middle Street for several years, later moving to Longfellow Square, where he continued until he disposed of the business in 1916 and came to Gorham.

UNITY — Alton R. Lowell, 78, died Sunday, Oct. 28, 1989, at a Waterville hospital, after a long illness. He was born Sept. 12, 1911, in Lee, the youngest son of Charles A. and Jane Standish (Nute) Lowell. Mr. Lowell attended the Lee schools and Lee Academy, and started a potato farming business in that town with other members of his family. He met Caroline E. Collins while she was on her first teaching assignment at Lee Academy, and they were married in September of 1935. In the 1930's, Mr. Lowell was a supervisor for the Farm Security Administration. Mr. Lowell was, for many years, active in Unity's town government as well as civic organizations including the Masonic Order; a charter member of the Unity Fire Department; one of the organizers of the Unity Civic Improvement Association; and for many years a principle on the Finance and Property Committees of the Unity Union Church. He is survived by his wife, Caroline Lowell of Unity; two sons, David Alton Lowell of Dallas, Texas, and Charles Frederick Lowell of Boston, Mass.; several nieces and nephews. Funeral services will be held 1 p.m. Wednesday at the Unity Union Church. A private burial will be in Mount Hope Cemetery, Bangor.
