CHELSEA — You could tell just by glancing at Arnold Harold Lundquist Sr. that this was a military man. His hair was never longer than a quarter-inch, his posture was always ramrod-straight and his clear blue eyes had a penetrating gaze and a Mess With Me At Your Peril intensity.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in lasting ways.

Yet he somehow managed to fool people. Mr. Lundquist spent many years as a counterintelligence agent — a spy, his son explained — including a five-year undercover stint in Maine. During those years in Augusta, his son was permitted to say that Mr. Lundquist worked for “the government,” but that was as close as he could get.

The many friends Mr. Lundquist made during those years never knew his true vocation.

“They may read it in the paper, in the obituary, and be astounded,” his son, Arnold Harold Lundquist Jr. of West Gardiner, said Sunday.

So now they are. Mr. Lundquist died on June 23, 2001. He was 85.

He was a faithful man, faithful to his country, his family and his word. He took his oath of secrecy seriously, and though his son has security clearance himself, Mr. Lundquist did not tell tales. “He won’t tell me because I don’t need to know,” his son said.

People knew that he received a Master Combat Parachutist Badge, a Combat Infantry Badge, a Bronze Star, a Purple Heart, a French Fourragere, a Belgian Fourragere and two Presidential Unit Citations. They knew he was in the parachute assault at Normandy and the Battle of the Bulge with the 82nd Airborne Division. But he chose to tell happy stories.

Mr. Lundquist was not a particularly well-educated man. He dropped out of high school and never went to college. But he valued education. He received a GED and made it clear that his son would attend college.

He had no patience for politicians and he hated traitors. For turncoats like Aldrich Ames, he held a special contempt.

“He would have an easy answer for that,” his son said. “Shoot ‘em. Period. Haul ‘em out in the street and shoot ‘em.”

He was a 50-year Mason, Past Grand Commander of the Commandry of Maine, Past Grand Master of the Grand Council of Maine, Past Worthy Patron of the Order of Amaranth and a member and leader of several Masonic bodies.

His wife, Barbara Mackay Lundquist, died in 1998. An infant daughter, Christine Lundquist, died previously.

Surviving are his son, Arnold H. Jr., of West Gardiner; two daughters, Mrs. John (Karen) Prater of Clovis, N.M., and Mrs. Jerry (Janet) Bumford of Augusta; five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Kennebunkport, April 1—Herbert L. Lucas, 81, former state legislator and trial justice here many years, died today at his home after a short illness.

Born at Biddeford, Nov. 4, 1861, he was a son of the late Samuel W. and Hanna Childs Lucas. He was graduated from Kents Hill Seminary and Dartmouth College, where he was president of his senior class and Pine Tree orator Class Day.

He studied law in his father's office and at Columbia Law School, and was admitted to the New York Bar in June, 1885. For a time he was a member of the New York City law firm of Derby and Lucas, then practiced alone until 1915, when he came to Kennebunkport. For many years he was attorney for the New York Retail Coal Exchange, and for seven years was a member of the Seventh Regiment, New York National Guard.

In 1916 he was elected first selectman here, serving for six years and refusing reelection. He represented this town, North Kennebunkport and Old Orchard Beach in the Maine Legislature in 1922-23 and served as trial justice three terms.

He had been president of the Lewis T. Groves Memorial Library here since its construction in 1916, was for many years president of the Kennebunkport Men's Club, was a member of the Kennebunk Rotary Club and of Arundel Lodge, F. & A. M. He was a trustee of the Congregational Church, and a member of Alpha Delta Phi Fraternity.

He is survived by his widow, Mary, and two sons, Arthur, of Texas, and Stanley, of Passaic, N. J.

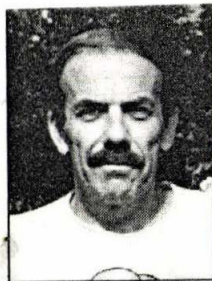
