NORWAY — Herbert Holmes Lyon, 84, of Bryant Pond died Wednesday, June 18.

He was born Sept. 1, 1918, at Woodstock, Conn., the son of George and Bernice (Bateman) Lyon. He was educated at Southern Maine Vocational/Technical Institute and had worked for 20 years as a homebuilder and cabinetmaker.

He was later employed by Central Maine Power as an instrument mechanic at Cousins Island in Yarmouth for 22 years retiring in 1980 and moving to Gore Road, Woodstock.

He married Mary Briggs in Spokane, Wash., on Oct. 2, 1943. He served in World War II in the U.S. Army 82nd General Hospital as a medical and surgical technician in the European Theatre of Operation.

He was a member of the Locke Mills Union Church of Greenwood, was past commander and life member of Jackson Silver Post 68 American Legion of Locke Mills, active in the Jefferson Lodge 100 A.F. & A. M. and OES 89 of Bryant Pond, Scottish Rites Body of Jacksonville, Fla., and the Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston and a life member of the Disabled American Veterans Association.

He was a registered Maine Guide for over 25 years and a Certified Instructor for Hunter Safety and Trapping Courses for the Maine Fish and Wildlife Department including Firearms instructor.

He is survived by his wife of 59 years; two sons, Ellsworth D. of Dudley, Mass., and George R. of Nashua, NH; one daughter, Grace Dixon and her husband Wayne of Alachua, Fla.; 10 grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.

STONEHAM — Daniel Elford "Mac" McAllister, 73, retired postmaster of Denmark, died Tuesday in a Norway hospital after a long illness.

Mr. McAllister worked for the U.S. Postal Service for 25 years, retiring in 1980.

PASSAGES

Each day the Press Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

"He was the first letter carrier in Fryeburg," said Charlie Lewis, the retired postmaster there. "It was in the mid-1960s, when the town instituted city delivery." Before that, mail was delivered to post office boxes and through rural delivery.

A skilled handcraftsman, Mr. McAllister made clocks out of horseshoes and made birdfeeders that looked like covered bridges.

"If you needed anything, he was right there," said Stanley

Brown, a longtime friend. "His clocks were very popular. He made quite a few lawn ornaments and things, too. He was very handy."

Born in Lovell, a son of Henry and Martha Bryant McAllister, he graduated from Fryeburg Academy in 1937. He served in the Army in France during World War II and received a Purple Heart as well as a French Citation award for his outfit's participation in action at the "Colmar pocket" on the Rhine River.

He lived many years on Stuart Street in Fryeburg before moving to Echo Acres on Five Kezars Pond in 1978. He worked in the woods for a while and had a bread route for Cushman's Baking Co. before joining the post office. In his retirement, he worked as a handyman.

He was the first commander of the Lovell Veterans of Foreign War Post, a past scoutmaster and a member of the Masons. He was a past president of the Interstate Snowgoers snowmobile club and the Crazy 8 Square Dance Club and was recordkeeper and treasurer of the Five Kezars Pond Association.

An avid fisherman, he was a member of the One-That-Didn't-Get-Away Club.

A son, Terrence, died in 1978.

He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Doris Gilman McAllister of Stoneham; two sons, Daniel E. Jr. of Hampden; and Conrad "Butch" of Norway; eight grandchildren and one great-grandchild.
