DR. JAMES H. MACDONALD

KENNEBUNK — Dr. James H. Macdonald, 66, prominent Kennebunk physician, died suddenly yesterday in the Maine Medical Center in Portland.

He was a graduate of the University of Toronto, and its medical school. He served in World War I as a captain in the medical corps with the Canadian Expeditionary Forces.

After the war he headed the Disabled Veterans Hospital in Fredericton, N.B. He later moved to Wells where he was connected with the Wells Sanitarium.

He was born Aug. 5, 1892, in Toronto, son of Mr. and Mrs. James Macdonald.

He was a director of the Ocean National Bank and the Kennebunk Building and Loan Assn., had been active in the York County Medical Assn., Maine and American Medical Assns. He had served as a York County medical examiner since 1931.

He was a member of the Rotary Club, the Knights Templar, other Masonic groups, Kennebunk Fire Society, Law Enforcement Assn., Fish and Game organizations, and was a communicant of the Episcopal Church.

He is survived by his widow, the former Helene Burr; a daughter, Mrs. Robert Nolan; a son, James A. Macdonald; a granddaughter, Cheryl Nolan; a sister, Mrs. Richard L. Hearn of Queenston, Ont.; and several nieces and nephews.

As a young man, Mr. Macdonald ran a barber shop in Brownfield. "He charged 25 cents a head," said his son, James. "Fifteen cents for a shave. He also had three pool tables in the barber shop. It was a good place for guys to go on a Saturday and hang out."

Around 1940, Mr. Macdonald moved to the restaurant business, becoming owner and operator of the former Mayfair Diner in Post Office Square. At the

same time, he managed the former Mayfair Theater next door.

"The diner was open 24 hours a day, seven days a week," James said.

Mr. Macdonald enjoyed hunting, and he added bear meat to the diner's menu whenever he shot a bear. "He served bear burgers and bear steak," said his son. "It was just a novelty."

After selling the diner, Mr. Macdonald opened an automotive repair garage in Bridgton, which he ran for a few years before founding the Macdonald Motors dealership.

For many years, Mr. Macdonald planted and maintained an apple orchard at his home on Pleasant Street. In recent years, he enjoyed investing in the stock market.

Born in Brownfield, a son of Frank and Catherine Rogers Macdonald, he graduated from Bean Memorial High School in Brownfield.

He married Mary Andrews Macdonald in 1937. She died in 1969.

Mr. Macdonald was a member of the Masons in Brownfield, York Rite Bodies in Bridgton and Kora Temple Shrine, Lewiston. He was an active member of the Bridgton First Congregational Church and of national and state automobile dealers associations.

He was a merchant mariner during World War II.

Augusta, Sept. 19—Frank E. Mace, 74, former Democratic Representative to the Legislature and twice State land agent and forest commissioner, died at his home here today.

Among the many positions he held during an active career in politics and civic affairs, Mr. Mace was local chairman of NRA and FHA committees, former president of the Augusta Kiwanis Club and served several years as president of the Augusta General Hospital. He also was identified with many local charitable and philanthropic organizations.

He was born at Aurora, Hancock County, June 11, 1863, and came to Augusta in 1911 as State Representative from Great Pond. At the conclusion of that session he was appointed land agent and forest commissioner by Gov. Frederick W. Plaisted, which position he filled for two years, returning to it again in 1915 by appointment of Gov. Oakley C. Curtis.
