ELLSWORTH — James A. MacKeen, 69, of 90 Stonybrook Road, Cape Elizabeth, the chief federal probation officer for Maine, collapsed and died yesterday at his camp at nearby Molasses Pond.

Medical Examiner James H. Crowe said death was caused by a coronary thrombosis.

Mr. MacKeen had been chief U. S. probation officer for the U. S. District Court of Maine since May 1, 1938.

He was born in Canning, N.S., July 22, 1895, son of Charles and Flora Steele MacKeen. He was a graduate of Acadia Collegiate Academy and attended Acadia College and Northeastern College.

He served with the Army Engineers in World War I as a lieutenant. As a young man he was employed by Stone and Webster and the General Electric Co., at Lynn, Mass. He later worked for 17 years for Morang, Robinson Co.

Mr. MacKeen served as probation officer of Hancock County from 1929 to 1938.

He was active in Boy Scout work and served as a district commissioner from 1917 to 1936. In 1946 he was a member of the Governor's Committee on Juvenile Delinquency.

He was a member of the Professional Council of the National Council on Crime and Delinquency from 1949 to 1957; a member of the Committee on Professional Standards of the National Probation and Parole Association from 1961 to 1963.

Mr. MacKeen was a member of the Portland Rotary Club for 26 years, and a member of the Portland Executives Club.

He was a member of the First Congregational Church of South Portland and its Eskimo Club. He belonged to Lagonia Lodge, AF&AM, Ellsworth, the Maine Charitable Mechanic Association, and the board of directors for the Cape Elizabeth Citizens Scholarship Foundation.

Besides his widow, the former Evelyn Mills, he leaves two daughters, Mrs. Joyce Rivers, Wilmington, Del., and Miss Judy MacKeen, Cape Elizabeth, a son, Capt. Arnold G. MacKeen, Offut AFB, Omaha, Neb.; a sister, Mrs. Ethel Rand Vancouver, B.C.; a brother, Donald MacKeen, Canning, N.S., one grandchild, and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be at 2:30 p.m. Thursday in the First Congregational Church, 301 Cottage Road, South Portland. Interment will be in Riverside Cemetery, Cape Elizabeth.

A graduate of Orono High School, he coached football there with an undefeated team for three years. He attended the University of Maine at Orono and the U.S. Radio School, Leavenworth, Kan., while a member of the Signal Corps during World War I.
