





Mr. MacKeen was a member of the Portland Rotary Club for 26 years, and a member of the Portland Executives Club.



He was born in Greenville on June 1, 1924, a son of Claude and Bertha Harrington MacMullen, and was educated in Brockton, Mass schools, graduating from


Brockton High School in 1942.
