



SOUTH PORTLAND - Roydon K. Maddocks, 85, a longtime Lucas Tree employee, died Wednesday at a ocal hospital.

He was born in Carlton, Ky., a son of Warren and Alice MacDonald Maddocks, and attended Portland schools.

Mr. Maddocks worked longer than 60 years for Lucas, retiring in 1988. He began employment with the original owner, Jack Lucas, whom he had a great deal of respect for, and was Lucas's superintendent of trees for many years.

He worked closely with Central Maine Power Co., overseeing the trimming and pruning trees along streets and power lines. He retired from the firm at least three times, but always returned part-time. The last position he held was as an errand man. He finally retired two years ago, when he could no longer pass his driver's . license examination.

Until recently he had been a superintendent of trees for the town of Cape Elizabeth, a sort of honorary position in which he would provide consultation on individual trees for town citizens.

He worked on several underground cable projects in Casco Bay during World War II.

He was a past exalted ruler of the Portland Lodge of Elks. When he stopped attending meetings about three years ago, he was the oldest living active past exalted ruler. He was a member of the Deering Lodge of Masons and was the first president of the Maine Arborists Association.

Mr. Maddocks was a founding member of Little League Baseball in Portland. He was a co-founder of Portland Little League One in 1951, and a league official for many years. League One's original field was at Thompson's Point.

He contributed greatly to statewide Little League activities and received a Governor's Award in 1967 from Gov. Kenneth M. Curtis for "giving unstintingly of time and professional talents to the regional and state organizations." He retired from LL One in the same year.

He is survived by his wife, Myrtle Woodrow Maddocks of South Portland; a daughter, Joan E. DeRice of Portland; three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
