Mr. Mann entered the US Army in June 1944. He attended Officer's Candidate School, Fort Benning, GA, in April 1945 and graduated as a 2nd Lt.

After the war ended in Europe, his division was the first one redeployed through the States to the Pacific area and went

into the occupation of Japan. Lt. Mann was assigned to the 5th Cavalry Regiment of the 1st Cavalry Division and was assigned as Recruiting Officer for the Regiment. After 15 months as a 2nd Lt. he was promoted to 1st Lt. In September of 1946 he was returned to the States and to civilian status. He rejoined S.D. Warren as the Technical Superintendent of the Pulp Mill; and in 1960 he became the Director. In 1966 he was transferred to the Research Department and joined the Operations Research Section. He retired from Research as Senior Research Scientist in 1981. Mr. Mann earned his M.S. Degree in 1975. His Master's Thesis was "Educational Use of Digital Computers." Mr. Mann joined Presumpcot Lodge # 127, A.F. & A.M. of North Windham, ME, in 1962 He also joined the York Rites, the Portland Commandery #2, and Kora Shrine Temple.
