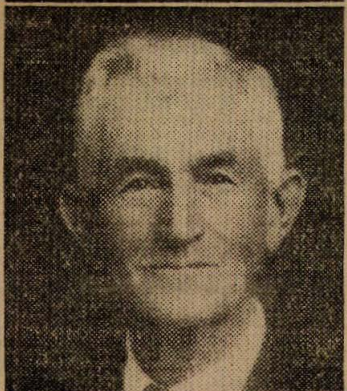

Windham, Sept. 17.—Joseph B. Manchester, age 67 years, died at his home at North Gorham quite suddenly Thursday afternoon following only a few hours of illness.

Mr. Manchester had not been in good health for the past year but had worked at his business of landscape gardening through the Spring and Summer. He had worked all day Wednesday and was taken ill during the night.

He was born in Standish, the son of Nahum and Martha Wakefield Manchester, but had spent the greater part of his life in Windham and North Gorham.
