Augusta, March 11 — Frank W. Manson, 67, editor of the Waterville Sentinel and Kennebec Journal, Augusta, since 1936 and former secretary to the late U. S. Senator Charles F. Johnson (D) of Waterville, died suddenly Thursday evening enroute to an Augusta hospital after being stricken with a heart attack while digging a draining trench in his vegetable garden in the yard of his home on Riverside Drive.

A native of Houlton, Manson was a graduate of Coburn Classical Institute in 1894 and from Colby College in 1898.



Manson started his newspaper career as Waterville correspondent for the Kennebec Journal immediately after being graduated from Colby. He became city editor of the Waterville Sentinel in 1903 and was night editor a few years later. After serving as secretary to Senator Johnson from 1911 to 1917, he became managing editor of the Sentinel and, shortly after, its editorial writer.

Manson's editorials were rated high both by persons in Maine and outside it. Arthur J. Roberts, former president of Colby, once

commented: "Mr. Manson once went to school under me and I am now going to school under him through his editorials."

Before the entry of the United States into World War Two, when Isolationist sentiment was strong in many quarters, Manson's editorials

sounded a strongly interventionist note and became widely quoted. On occasions they were discussed and quoted in Congress.

After America entered the war, he was one of the first men to become a "spotter" at Augusta's Airplane Observation Post and took considerable pride in the fact that he never had missed a tour of duty there.

In former years Manson had written short stories for Munsey's Magazine, no longer published, under the pen name of Frank Waldo (his middle name).

Manson was an intimate friend of the late William R. Pattangall, chief justice of Maine, whom he had followed during the chief justice's career.

He was a charter member of the Waterville Rotary Club and a member of the Siloam Lodge of Masons at Fairfield.

Surviving are three cousins, Mrs. Jessie Souwers of Hodgdon, Mrs. Otis Wardward of Bangor and Mrs. Blanche Ellis of Rangely. Funeral services will be held at 11 a. m. Saturday at the Plumber Funeral Parlor, Augusta.
