THOMASTON — Former state Public Safety Commissioner J. Edward Marks, known as the "dean of state police," died Tuesday morning in a Portland hospital of a heart attack.

Marks retired in 1975 as public safety commissioner after serving 50 years with the Maine State Police. The Thomaston resident enlisted into the state police in 1925, and was promoted to sergeant in 1933.

As a lieutenant in 1936, Marks was placed in charge of Troop D, Thomaston barracks, and in 1945 was named to head Troops A, B and D, encompassing barracks in southern and midcoast Maine.

Marks left the Thomaston barracks in 1959, when he was named director of the Bureau of Criminal Investigation. (There are now three criminal divisions in the state.) He also was placed in charge of the State Bureau of Identification during that time.

Born in Pittston, he was the son of Charles and Maude Fossett Marks.

A graduate of Gardiner High School, class of 1922, he was a star athlete. He participated in the olympic trials in 1924 and was amateur New England wrestling champion.

He was the husband of Geraldine Smith Marks.

Major Marks was a 55-year member of Hermon Lodge in Gardiner, and a member of the Scottish Rite Valley of Augusta, Kora Temple Shrine, Lewiston, the Royal Order of Jesters, the Mid-Coast Shrine Club, Rockland, Merrymeeting Shrine Club, Brunswick, the Consistory, Portland, the York Rite of Gardiner

He was born in Austria, son of John and Anna Marks. He came to the United States at age 14.

Mr. Marks was a decorated World War I U.S. Army veteran, serving in the battles of Montidier-Noyon front, the St. Michel front, the Aisne-Marne, the Argonne and the Defensive Sector.

He was a retail salesman for General Foods Corp. and later served as manager in charge of sales and personnel in Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont. He retired in 1961.

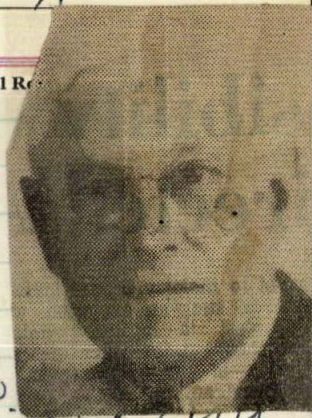

SANFORD — Retired textile industrialist William Henry Marland, 85, died in his home here today following a long illness.

He served as a director, president and general manager of the Sanford Mills and as a director, chairman of the board, and president of Goodall Worsted Co. He was president of both firms when they merged as Goodall-Sanford, Inc., in 1944. He retired soon after. Mr. Marland was born July 6, 1871, at Corning, N.Y., and was graduated from Cornell University in 1901. Two years later he was married to Miss Marion Goodall. She was a granddaughter of Thomas Goodall, who founded the Sanford Mills. She died in 1958.

Mr. Marland entered business in Binghamton, N.Y. He began his career in the local company as head of the leather department and agent for the Sanford Mills at Reading, Mass.

He served many years as chairman of the board of the

Henrietta D. Goodall Hospital here and was active in the Masons and other organizations.

He was a trustee of Nason College from 1945 to 1954. At that time, he was elected trustee emeritus.

A women's residence at the college was opened two years ago at Nason and named for him.

A Clinton resident, he attended Brown Memorial Methodist Church, where he was on the Board of Trustees. He served on the call force of Clinton Fire Department for four years. He loved carpentry and fine woodworking and bluegrass music, and was an avid Lawrence Bulldogs basketball fan.

Survivors include his wife of 21 years, Ann Marie (Susee) Marquis, one son, Kyle Steven Marquis and daughter, Lindsey Crystal Marquis, all of Clinton; his parents; two brothers, Scott and his wife Jocelyn of Presque Isle, Brent and his wife, Cindy of Easton; two sisters, Carolyn Lyford and her husband James and Barbara McIntyre, all of Presque Isle; mother-in-law, Elizabeth Bragg and her husband, Leroy of Crouseville; father-in-law, Robert Susee of Clinton; maternal grandmother, Cassie Roix of Presque Isle; several nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by his maternal grandfather, Wallace Roix, and paternal grandparents, John and Rachel Marquis, all formerly of Presque Isle.

A firefighter's tribute will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday at Central Station with a memorial service at 1 p.m. in Colby College Gymnasium. Arrangements are by Pine State Cremation Service.

Newport, Aug. 7.—The Rev. Harry Havelock Marr, pastor of the Methodist Church here died suddenly, Thursday noon, while he and Mrs. Marr were guests of Mr. and Mrs. J. O.
