YORK HARBOR — Fred W. Marshall, 89, a retired superintendent and division manager for Central Maine Power Co., died yesterday at a local hospital. He also served in the State Senate and House of Representatives.

He was born in Groton, Mass., Feb. 10, 1878, son of Samuel Bradbury Marshall and Ida Moulton. His grandfather built the Marshall House Hotel.

Mr. Marshall operated the first steam generator which provided York with summer electricity until 1910 when power was then obtained from Dover, N.H.

He worked for five power companies until his retirement in 1945 from Central Maine. He had been a dedimus justice since 1945, and a member of the Board of Assessors since 1947 and was harbor corporation clerk for 20 years.

Mr. Marshall served in the House of Representatives from 1945 to 1949 and in the State Senate from 1951-1952. For five years he was a deputy sheriff under Sheriff Haven Roberts and was county coroner 1911-1913.

He was a member of the York Republican Town Committee and its chairman for 26 years. He also served for six years on the county committee.

Mr. Marshall was a 50 year member of St. Aspinquid Lodge, AF & AM, and a member of Central Maine Power Old Timers Club

Memorial services for George A. Marshall, 99, of Vacaville were Thursday at his Leisure Town home.

The Rev. Ron Shaw officiated. Mr. Marshall's ashes are to be returned to his native Maine.

Mr. Marshall died Dec. 20, 1995, at his home after a short illness. Born April 21, 1896, in Portland, Maine, Mr. Marshall moved to Vacaville in 1975. He was wounded while serving in the Army and stationed in France during World War I.

Mr. Marshall graduated from Bates College in Lewiston, Maine, in 1925 and worked for 20 years in Maine for Crane Co., a Chicago-based plumbing and heating company.

During World War II, Mr. Marshall worked as a civilian purchasing agent for the Navy in Portland, Maine. He then was a real estate broker in Maine and California for more than 18 years.

Mr. Marshall was a member of the Masons in Maine and California, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and several Leisure Town groups.

Mr. Marshall is survived by his wife, Marie of Vacaville; daughter, Louise Follett of Vacaville; a brother, Dr. Donald Marshall of Maine; a grandson; two great-granddaughters; and numerous nieces and nephews.

SANFORD — James H. Marshall, 52, of 62 Main St., died unexpectedly Sunday at a local hospital.

He was born in Sanford, the son of Harry and Marion Welch Marshall, and he had resided here all of his life.

Mr. Marshall graduated from Sanford High School in 1944 and enlisted in the Navy. He played in the U.S. Navy Band for two years and traveled extensively to entertain the troops during World War II, both in the U.S. and overseas.

He also served in the New York City area with the big bands of the era, promoting the sale of U.S. Savings Bonds.

Mr. Marshall was, until his retirement in September of 1952, vice president and general manager of the Emery Waterhouse Company, Portland wholesaler of hardware and appliances.

Widely Known As A Specialist For Children

DR. LINN B. MARSHALL, 52, specialist in children's diseases, who had charge of inoculation of Portland's school children against diphtheria, died at his home, 1028 Congress Street, this morning.

Death was due to heart disease. Dr. Marshall had been in poor health all winter, and was seriously ill six weeks.

In the seven years that the City of Portland has been conducting toxin-anti-toxin clinics in its public schools, Dr. Marshall inoculated more than 12,000 children, aided by public health nurses.

The specialist also gave freely of his time to charity work, conducting three baby clinics every week two at the Board of Health offices in City Hall, and one in the Libby School, Congress and Powsland Streets.

During the World War, Dr. Marshall served two years in the British Army's Medical Corps.

Born in Cambridge, Mass., Dr. Marshall was a Portlander most of his life. He was graduated from Hebron Academy in 1902, attended Bowdoin Medical School in this City, and was graduated from the University of Colorado's medical school in 1911.

Returning to Maine, Dr. Marshall began the practice of his profession at Hebron Academy, and remained there three years. After his service overseas with the British forces, the doctor returned to Portland in 1919
