He loved the woods and cut and split nine cord of wood for his family every season. Mr. Mattson was always a happy go lucky person, who left an impression on everyone he met being an avid conversationalist and story teller. He was a devoted husband to his wife, Bernys Overlock, who he married on Feb. 28, 1948 and a devoted father to his children. His weekly family routine included coffee with his son-in-law, David during the week and with his daughter and son-in-law, Kurt on weekends. He was predeceased by a daughter, Barbara J. Wing on Jan. 21, 1999, a sister Dorothy Hagerman, and a brother, Albert Mattson. He is

survived by his wife of 55 years, Bernys; a daughter; Roberta E. Tielinen of New Gloucester and son-in-law, Kurt E. Tielinen, Sr., son-in-law, David L. Wing of New Gloucester; a grandson, Adam E. Tielinen of New Gloucester; a sister, Marjorie Ahola of Petaluma, Calif.; seven stepgrandchildren, David Lawler of West Palm Beach, Anthony Wing of Greenville, Robert Wing of Raymond, Todd Wing of New Gloucester, Kurt Tielinen, Jr of Saco, Kimberly Piche of Biddeford, and Karlene Mooers of Biddeford.
