MACHIAS — Fred Perry Mawhinney, 73, died Sept. 1, 1992, at his home. He was born at Lynn, Mass., March 16, 1919, the son of Fred W. and Vivian (Perry) Mawhinney. He was educated in the Machias schools, at Hebron Academy and graduated from Bowdoin College, Class of 1941. At Bowdoin College, he was president of the White Key Honor Society and was a member of Chi Psi fraternity. A lieutenant commander in the U.S. Navy during World War II, he skippered the Naval ships: Edgar Allen Poe, the North Star and the Carib. He was the youngest Naval commander in the Pacific fleet during World War II. He owned and operated Mawhinney Motor Co. in Machias for 40 years. During that time, he was on the board of directors and an officer of Machias Savings Bank. His fraternal memberships included: Harwood Lodge No. 91 AF & AM of Machias, Anah Temple Shrine of Bangor and the Elks. He was an avid outdoorsman and a licensed Maine guide since 1939. Surviving are his mother, Vivian (Perry) Mawhinney of Ellsworth; his wife, Helen (Wallingford) Mawhinney of Machias; one son, Daniel Mawhinney and his wife, Diane of Auburn; one daughter, Jean Ewell and her husband, Dana, of Garland; three sisters, Muriel Berry and Julia Calor, both of Ellsworth, and Lillian Umstead of Florida; five grandchildren, one niece, several nephews. There will be no calling hours. A memorial service will be held 1:30 p.m. Thursday at Centre Street Congregational Church, Machias, with the Rev. Norman Duzen officiating. 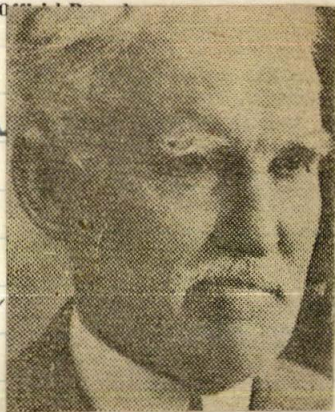

Josiah E. Maxcy, 81, Dies At Gardiner Home

Was Pioneer In Development
Of Water Works And Active
In Bank Management

Special Despatch to The Press Herald

Gardiner, Jan. 19.—Josiah E. Maxcy, 81, closely identified with varied business interests in New England, a pioneer in the development of water works systems and for more than 25 years president of the Gardiner Savings Institution, died this morning at his home on Pleasant Street.

Mr. Maxcy was born Sept. 13, 1854, at Gardiner. His term as head of the Gardiner Savings Institution was the longest of any president and at that time he had also been active in the management of other Maine banks. He had been general manager of 12 water systems at one time.

Mr. Maxcy was president of the Gardiner General Hospital and of the Squirrel Island Village Association, vice president of the Maine Historical Society, treasurer and general manager of the Calais Water and Power Company and formerly a trustee of Hebron Academy. He was a 32nd degree Mason and a member of the Sons of the American Revolution.
