## Josiah K. Maxcy, 81, Dies At Gardiner Home


Was Pioneer In Development

Special Despatch to The Press Herald Gardiner, Jan. 19.—Josiah K Maxcy, 81, closely identified with varied business interests in New England, a pioneer in the development of water works systems and for more than 25 years president of the Gardiner Savings Institution, died this morning at his home on Pleasant Street.







and Limington Grange.


