Herbert R. McBride, 79, of Eastman Avenue died Monday in a local hospital after a long illness.

He was born in Bellville, New Brunswick, son of Claude A. and Alice P. McBride McBride, and attended Bellville schools.

In 1939, Mr. McBride moved here and met his wife-to-be Eleanor Titcomb. In 1942 he joined the Army and was stationed in the Pacific. He saw action on most of the islands. After his discharge in 1945, he received his U.S. citizenship.

He began his construction career with the International Association of Bridge & Structural, Ornamental Iron Workers. Working for various companies, Mr. McBride traveled in all lower-48 states working on projects that included the Black Hills Memorial, missile silos in northern New York state, various paper mills throughout the Northeast and many major bridges, the communication towers at Cutler, Tellstar and the Texas

towers.

Later, with Burns Door Corp., he supervised erection of hangars for Loring Air Force Base at Limestone. With L.C. Vanderbeck of Hawthorn, N.J., he supervised reconstruction of the former Ford Motor Co. plant in Mauwan, N.J., and the Pratt & Whitney Plant in Hartford, Conn.

Still later, he worked for Atlantic Roofing & Skylight Works on projects that included the Maine Yankee nuclear plant at Wiscasset, Scott Paper in Hinkley, and International Paper in Jay.

Mr. McBride retired in 1973 and served as a consultant for the construction business of his son, Jim, who said his father's ability to estimate, communicate and deliver a project were incredible.

Mr. McBride especially loved northern Maine and New Brunswick.

He was a member of the Long Island VFW, the Portland Lions, Cornerstone Lodge of Masons and the Order of the Eastern Star, Scottish Rite Bodies, Royal Arch Chapter and Kora Shrine. He attended the North Deering Church.

Surviving, besides his wife, are a son, James H. of West Falmouth, and a sister, Elva Leavitt of Saint John, New Brunswick.

Visiting hours will be from 7 to 9 p.m. Friday at Hay Funeral Home, 795 Main St., Westbrook, where a funeral will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday.

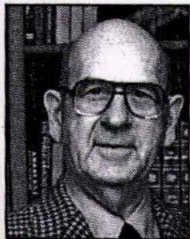
