Captain Edwin P. McDuffie, 93, a retired Portland harbor pilot, of 340 Eastern Promenade, formerly of 142 Concord St., died Tuesday in a local nursing home after a long illness.

Born in Portland, a son of Capt. Charles W.L. and Hannah Goff McDuffie, he graduated from Portland High School in 1915.

Capt. McDuffie began his career on tugboats in 1914, working summers for the Randall and McAllister Co., which towed coal-carrying vessels into Portland's waterfront.

EDITOR'S NOTE

Capt. McDuffie as a pilot supervised the launching of all the Liberty Ships from the East and West shipyards in South Portland.



In 1945 he was piloting the South Portland-built Liberty Ship, Robert Gordon, through the draw of the "Million Dollar Bridge" when the brand new ship's steering gear failed. The damage to the South Portland side of the bridge caused the draw to remain open for repairs for three months, forcing

Edwin McDuffie Sr. ing commuters around to the former Vaughan's Bridge, which ran from Commercial Street to Route 1 near Cash Corner.

Over his 58-year career, Capt. McDuffie either guided or controlled just about every kind of ship to enter Portland harbor: becalmed three- and six-masted schooners, square riggers, aircraft carriers, tankers, freighters, submarines, Coast Guard vessels and even President Johnson's command ship, the North Hampton. He retired as a harbor pilot in 1976.

A World War I veteran, he was the last surviving member of the Portland Light Infantry Division out of Portland's Cumberland Barracks.

He was a 50-year member of Ancient Landmarks Lodge of Masons, a past president of Portland Marine Society and McDuffie Pilots Inc., a member of Woodfords Congregational Church and former member of the Portland Propeller Club.

His wife, Helen A. McDuffie, died last March.

Capt. Charles W. L. McDuffie, 85, veteran tow boat skipper and prominent waterfront figure for nearly three-quarters of a century, died Wednesday noon in his home, 12 Rosedale Street.

The former harbor master and widely recognized expert on water front affairs started working on tow boats before he was 14. His perseverance and energy pushed him ahead rapidly in his chosen field and he became master of the tow boat Demerisk at 21.

From then until his retirement in February, 1947, he skippered seven boats for the Central Wharf Tow Boat Company, with which he was associated from the company's beginning. He was the company's senior captain for more than 40 years.

Named Harbor Master

He served several times as deputy harbor master and in 1928 was appointed harbor master, a post which he held for several years.

At the twilight of his career he was master of the Cumberland, now inactive, and was considered a prime source of information and advice on harbor activities.

In his lifetime he put more than 20,000 tankers through the narrow draw of the Portland bridge, more than enough in his own words "to reach from Cape Elizabeth to Land's End, England," if placed end to end.

Captain McDuffie was born in Portland, March 15, 1866, son of Robert and Annie Bradenburg McDuffie. He was educated in the grade schools and Portland Evening School and was a member of Atlantic Lodge, AF & AM.

He is survived by a brother, Ernest G. McDuffie, shipmate and engineer aboard his tugs for more than 50 years; four sons, Albert J. and Charles C., both of Portland, the Rev. William L. McDuffie, Brookline, Mass., and Capt. Edwin P. McDuffie, who succeeded him as senior captain with the Central Wharf Tow Boat Company; four daughters, Mrs. Charles Buck of Norway; Mrs. Helen Lowell of Los Angeles, Calif.; and Mrs. Munson Strout and Mrs. Lemuel Soule, both of Portland.

He also is survived by four sisters, Mrs. Fred Tibbetts of Springfield, Mass., and Mrs. Ellen Allen, Mrs. Samuel Goodey and Mrs. Maud Aborn, all of Portland.

His wife, the former Hannah E. Goff, died in 1947.

The funeral will be at 2 p. m. Saturday at 749 Congress Street. Interment will be in Pine Grove Cemetery, Falmouth.
