William R. McDonald, six times mayor of South Portland, died Saturday at his home, 235 High Street, that City. He had been in poor health two months.

A pioneer sardine packer, Mr. McDonald was president of the W. W. Brown Company, South Portland, at the time of his death. He was a strong Republican and had served several years as chairman of the First District Republican Committee.

Mr. McDonald was born at Cutler, Jan. 19, 1867, son of Malcolm and Mary (Warren) McDonald. He was graduated from Bryant-Stratton Business College, Boston, drove a mail stage from Lubec to Machias, entered the sardine industry at Lubec where he was associated with the Eureka Packing Company and in 1904 joined the E. W. Brown Company, then located at Port Clyde.

In 1910 Mr. McDonald came to South Portland when the Brown business transferred to that city and became president of the firm in 1914. He was also the first president of the Maine Sardine Packing Association and a member of Washington Lodge, F. and A. M.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Ada Manning McDonald; two sons, William R., Jr., and Islay McDonald; one granddaughter, Ruth Ada McDonald, all of South Portland; one sister, Mrs. Hubert E. Saunders of Lubec, and several nieces and nephews.
