Dr. Barron F. McIntire Jr. physician who 'believed in family'

YARMOUTH - Dr. Barron Filmore McIntire Jr., an old fashioned family doctor who liked to make house calls, died Thursday at his home on West Elm Street. He wns 81.

"He was very much a family person," said his son, Rolvin McIntire of Freeport. "He just believed so strongly in family and in doing things together and helping people. That's why he liked being a doctor." Dr. McIntire was born

much of his childhood at the cottage and it would become an important part of his adult life. "Pemaquid was his

love," Rolvin McIntire snid.

Dr. McIntire was a 1934 graduate of Woodsville High School and a

1938 graduate of Dartmouth College.

He attended Dartmouth Medical School for two years and was a 1941 graduate of Rush Medical School at the University of Chicago.

While at Dartmouth Medical School, Dr. Melntire was a member of the AKK and Zeta Psi fratemities. He served his internship and residency at Maine General Hospital, now Maine Medical Center, between 1941 and 1947.

From 1942 until 1946, Dr. McIntire served as a first lieutenant in the Army. He was stationed at Camp Langdon Station Hospital in New Castle, N.H., the 115th Station Hospital in Tavistock, England and the 443rd AAA Battalion in Germany

On Sept. 14, 1942, he married Rhoda Atwood McIntire, a registered nurse. They opened a medical practice together in Yarmouth in October 1947, and Dr. McIntire practiced there until his retirement in 1981.

"He really loved children, and he just loved practicing medicine " Rolvin McIntire recalled.

Rolvin McIntire said that his father used to take him and his brothers along on house calls on Saturdays. On other days. Mr. McIntire would rise at 6 a.m., do his house calls, then spend the afternoon seeing patients in his office

He often didn't get home until 9 p.m., his son said, "but he just loved it "

"People would call him, and if they called him at two o'clock in the morning for something, he didn't complain about it," Rolvin McIntire said. "He'd say, 'I've got to take care of this person."

Dr. McIntire also served as the school physician for Yarmouth schools, North Yarmouth Academy, and the Cumberland and North Yarmouth schools. He was the medical director for both Bren-

twood Manor and Coastal Manor nursing homes for 10 years. He was a member of the Casco

Lodge of Masons, the Maine Medical Association and the American Medical Association He was a former vice president of the Cumberland County Medical Association, the American Academy of General Practice, Yarmouth's Board of Health and a member of the medical staff of

both Maine Medical Center and Mercy Hospital. Dr. McIntire was honored by the town of Yarmouth in 1981 with the Latch String Award, which recognized his many years of service to residents. He also received the Community Better Life Award from the American Nursing Home Association in 1975, and received dedicated service awards from both the Yarmouth School Department and the Yarmouth Teachers Association in 1981. In 1985 he received an award from Yarmouth for serving on the Board of Health.

One of Mr. Melntire's favorite hobbies was woodworking, his son recalled, and just before Christmas this year he made something special for every member of the family: A daughter in law got a rocking horse, a grandchild got a plane that looked like the Spirit of St. Louis and a nephew's wife got a light shaped like Noah's Ark.

"He'd get wish lists from people," his son recalled. "They'd say, 'You know, I've always wanted a little bookcase,' or 'Tve always wanted a wooden rocking horse.' He'd dream up the patterns and he'd make it for thom "

Over the years, he made a wooden rocking horse for each of his grandchildren

Dr. McIntire's other love was fishing at Pernaguid. He spent every summer at the family cottage, fishing for bluefish and striped bass from his 14-foot boat.

"Every time that I would go down on weekends, he would say, 'Geez, is that fish out there jumping? Do you suppose we should go check that out?" " Rolvin McIntire recalled. "He just loved to get a fishing pole."

In his later years, Dr. McIntire was disappointed to see medicine become so intertwined with the bottom line **Rolvin Melntire said**

"When he practiced, you always saw a doctor," he said. "If you were burt and didn't have anything, it didn't matter. He went out and took care of you. He was very saddened because that's not the way it works today. He said. 'Oh I guess I got out of medicine just in time.'"

His wife died in 1994. A son, Kevin S. McIntire, died in 1997

Surviving are two sons, Barron F. McIntire III of Denver, Colo, and Rolvin W. McIntire II of Freeport; and two grandchildren. Tina Marie McIntire and Christian **Robert McIntire**

BIDDEFORD (AP)-Rep. Clifford G. McIntire's 89 - year - old father, Frank, died at St. Petersburg, Fla., yesterday.

The Republican Congressman from Maine's 2nd District learned of his father's death while in Biddeford and canceled a speech he had scheduled last night before the Arundel Republican Women's Club at the Kennebunk Inn in nearby Kennebunkport.

It was to have been McIntire's second public speech since his announcement last week that he would seek promotion to the Senate.

The Congressman said his father died unexpectedly of a lung hemorrhage. The retired potato grower had been in excellent health, his son said.

A lifelong resident of Perham, in Aroostook County, the elder McIntire had been retired nearly 20 years and spent each midwinter in Florida.

Besides the Congressman, he leaves another son, Smith of Perham, who is Clifford's twin, and a daughter Mrs. Bearl Flewelling of Crousville.

Frank McIntire had been a Mason 60 years. He also was a Granger and active in the Baptist Church at Perham.

His first wife, the former Velma Smith, died in 1931. McIntire later married Mrs. Florence Everett of Brewer and she died two years ago.

Paul H. McIntire, 53, principal of the city's Urban School District 1 since 1935, and connected with the Portland schools for 26 years, died suddenly in his home, 14 Lawn Avenue, Sunday morning of heart ailment.

Mr. McIntire had been in charge of North, Wilson, Isabella Garvin and Staples Schools for the past 14 years and for 12 years prior to that taught history in Portland High School. He was born at North Yar-

mouth Oct. 19, 1895, son of Edwin M. and Grace Lufkin McIntire. He received his early schooling there and was graduated from Greely Institute, Cumberland Center. In 1917 he was graduated from Bowdoin College.

The next year he was named submaster of Greely Institute and held that position until 1919 when he was named principal of Wells High School.

Four years later he left Wells for the teaching position at Portland High and in 1935 was named to his present post to succeed Elmer E. Parmenter. Mr. McIntire was active in local

and state educational organizations, including the Portland Teachers' Association, of which he once was president, and several years secretary, and the State Teachers' Association.
