WALDOBORO – Ernest Reginald McLain, 70, died Sunday at a Rockport hospital after a long illness.

## HARLAN MCLAIN

WALDOBORO — Harlan Gifford McLain, 83, died at home Aug. 29, 2004.

He was born March 14, 1921, in Bremen, a son of Harris H. and Geneva Gifford McLain. He attended grammar school in Bremen and was a graduate of Waldoboro High School. He married Eileen Chapman.

As a young man, he worked at Bath Iron Works until April 21, 1943, when he began his service in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was honorably discharged Oct. 10, 1945.
