## John W. McManus former B & M plant manager

John W. McManus, 80, a former plant manager for Burnham & Morrill Baking Co. and a veteran of two wars, died Wednesday at his home here after a long illness.

Mr. McManus was the fourth generation in the McManus family to work at the baked-beans plant in East Deering. His father and grandfather both had been plant managers at B & M, and his great-grandfather was a supervisor there. Mr. McManus retired in 1983 after 45 years with the company.

"It was a big part of his life," said his niece, Jayne E. Nielsen.

Mr. McManus was plant manager when B & M was acquired in 1964 by the Underwood Co. of Massachusetts. He stayed with Underwood and was transferred to Dover, Del., to manage a packing plant. He also set up a bean-baking operation at Santa Clara Baking Co., San Jose, Calif.

He never married and didn't have children, but he was always very close to his niece and nephews, said Nielsen. "Because he enjoyed meeting people, he didn't mind traveling to help manage other plants."

Mr. McManus started with B & M right out of high school and worked there until enlisting in the Navy in 1939.

During World War II, he served in both the European and Pacific theaters, serving on board the USS Roper. The Roper was credited with sinking the first German submarine at the start of the war, said his niece.

He retired from the Navy in 1945 as a chief petty officer in communications.

He joined the Naval Reserve after the war, and was recalled to active duty for the Korean War. During that time he taught radio courses, retiring again from the Navy in 1952.

Every few years since then, he would get together for a reunion with fellow sailors who served aboard the Roper.

Mr. McManus enjoyed boating and for many years kept a converted lobster boat moored just offshore from the bean plant.

He also enjoyed golf, and played often at local courses during his retirement until he became ill.

Born in Portland, a son of Percy C. and Sadie Jenkins McManus, he graduated in 1937 from Deering High School.

He was a member of Cornerstone Masonic Lodge, Portland; the Scottish Rite Bodies of Portland; the Kora Temple Shrine, Lewiston; the Kora Shrine Club; the Navy League; the U.S. Navy Memorial Foundation; and the Four Stack APD Veterans of World War II; and he served on the committee for reunions of the USS Roper. He was past president of Burnham and Morrill's 25-Year Club and a member of the Woodfords Club, Heartline and the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Surviving are a brother, Warren E. of Falmouth; a sister, Natalie J. McManus of Portland; a niece, Jayne E. Nielsen; and three nephews, Warren E. Jr., Wilder J. and Thomas P. McManus.

Visiting hours will be held from 2 to 4 and 7 to 9 p.m. today at Hobbs Funeral Home, South Portland. A funeral will be held at 1 p.m. Friday at the funeral home. Spring burial will be in Mount Pleasant Cemetery, South Portland.

**Limerick, Dec. 1.**—The funeral for Charles Hodge MacMillan, 82, onetime steel company executive, was held at the Congregational Church here Tuesday. Mr. MacMillan, son of the Rev. George Whitefield and Nancy Aiken MacMillan, died Nov. 23 in Maine General Hospital, Portland.

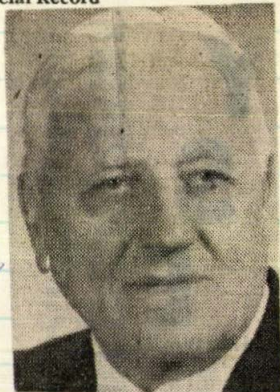
