




He had lived in Standish for 32 years, coming from Westbrook.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at the Windham Hills Church. Interment will be in Friendship Cemetery here.





Police said one burner of the apartment's gas stove was on and the stove's pilot light had gone out.




