OWLS HEAD - Alvin Hurd McNeilly, 44, husband of Elaine Mailloux McNeilly, a former Maine Department of Environmental Protection employee, died at a Portland hospital from injuries suffered Friday in an automobile accident in Newcastle.

He was born in Brookline, Mass., a son of Alvin S. and Jennie Bridges McNeilly. He lived in Melrose, Mass., and White Plains, N.Y., as a child, graduating from White Plains High School, where he was active in football and baseball. In 1971, he graduated from the University of Virginia with a degree in chemical engineering.

The McNeillys were married Nov. 3, 1972, in Hampton, Va.

For more than 16 years, he worked around the country, including in Derry, N.H., and Providence, R.I., for Gulf Oil Co. as an engineer and industrial/commercial representative.

In 1983, he moved to Owls Head, where he had summered since his youth.

Mr. McNeilly then began working at the Maine Department of Environmental Protection as an oil and hazardous waste materials specialist. He stopped working in 1989 after being diagnosed with cancer.

While living in Derry, he was a member of the Hoodcroft Golf Club, where he set the course record and was a club champion several times.

Since moving to Owls Head, he was a member of the Congregational Church of Rockland, and Knox Masonic Lodge, South Thomaston, where he was master in 1986. He was past president of the Ash Point Cemetery Association and was active in the Camden YMCA.

Surviving are his wife; his father and stepmother, Judith French McNeilly; a son, Alvin Michael Hurd, and a daughter, Katie Virginia, all of Owls Head; a brother, Marc T. of Bangor; a stepbrother, Sam Johnson of

WEST BATH - Verl W. McNelly, a longtime employee of the former Hyde Windlass Corp. in Bath, died Wednesday at Mid Coast Hospital in Bath. He was 81 and lived on Berry's Mill Road.

For 26 years, Mr. McNelly was a machinist at Hyde Windlass. That company manufactured windlasses and other deck machinery for ships from 1896 until 1961, when it was bought by Bath Iron Works. The company operated as a division of BIW for eight years, and by 1969 all of its 160 employees were phased into BIW. Mr. McNelly worked in security at BIW until retiring in 1976.

During the 1930s, Mr. McNelly served for 3½ years with the Army in Hawaii.

A native of Dyer Brook in Aroostook County, he moved to West Bath in 1941 to take the job with Hyde Windlass. He bought land on Berry's Mill Road and built a house there that he has lived in since 1941.

It was originally a small house, and he built additions a few times over the years to accommodate his growing family, according to his son, Dale.

Mr. McNelly enjoyed hunting and fishing. He mostly hunted and fished in the area around the camp he owned in Dyer Brook. "He'd go up there for a week at a time," said his son, Dale.

Mr. McNelly kept a garden and was active in West Bath town meetings, according to Anthony Ouellette, a longtime friend and neighbor.

He was a member of the Polar Masonic Lodge, a past master of West Bath Grange, a longtime member of West Bath Fire Department and West Bath Cemetery Association. He was a member of the Coasters and the Bath Area Senior Citizens.

He was a son of Joseph and Cora McLaughlin McNelly, and he attended schools in Dyer Brook.

Surviving are his wife of 54 years, Helen I. Gray McNelly; five sons, Roger V. and Everett J., both of West Bath, Edgar R. of Portland, Dale E. of Yarmouth and Jeffrey L. of Waldoboro; two brothers, Laurel and Harold, both of Dyer Brook; two sisters, Mrs. Frank (Stella) Lariee of Millinocket and Mrs. Fraser (Pearl) Botting of Oakfield; six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

A funeral will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday at David E. Desmond Funeral Home, Bath. The Rev. William Baxter will officiate. Burial will be in Orchard Hill Cemetery.
