KENNEBUNKPORT — Frank S.E. McRae, 92, of Goose Rocks Beach, died Saturday in a Portland hospital after a brief illness.

Born in Bayswater, New Brunswick, he was the son of William J. and Sara Eaton McRae. He attended Bayswater and St. John schools.

As a young man he was employed as a scaler in the woods of Canada.

Prior to World War I, Mr. McRae was employed with the T.H. Esterbrook Co. of St. John.

During World War I he was a lieutenant in the Royal Air Force and an observation officer. After the war he represented the province of New Brunswick in the formation of the Royal Canadian Air Force.

He was employed with the Socony Vacume Oil Co. in Maine for more than 15 years, after which he formed his own company, the Frank S.E. McRae Co. Jobbers and Distributors.

He was a well-known amateur magician in Maine since 1925 and was a member of the Maine Magicians' Association.

He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Portland and attended the Village Baptist Church of Kennebunkport. He was a member of the Arundel Lodge of Masons, the Maine Consistory of Portland, the Kora Shrine Temple of Lewiston, and the Kennebec and York County Shrine Clubs.

His wife, Helen Brewer McRae, died in 1967.

Mr. McRae is survived by a daughter, Mrs. John (Frances) Bove of Falmouth; three grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

FRYEBURG — Thomas E. McSherry, 89, of Main Street, who opened one of the first pick-your-own apple orchards in Maine, died April 12, 2001, at Memorial Hospital in North Conway, N.H.

He was born in Lewiston, a son of John and Mae Irving McSherry. He attended local schools and the Bartlett

School of Arboriculture in Stamford, Conn., and took classes in orchard management at the University of Maine.

"Where the interest in apples came from, I don't know," said his daughter, Gail McSherry. "He planted his first orchard in Sweden. He probably had a person or two to help him, but it was mostly him. That orchard is about 60 acres now."

In 1931 he moved to Fryeburg and in 1933 founded McSherry's Apple Orchard where he

grew McIntosh, cortland, red delicious, yellow delicious and northern spy apples, as well as some old-fashioned varieties.

In 1938 he opened one of the first first pick-your-own orchards in the state in Hiram.

He was one of Maine's first licensed arborists and served as director of the Maine Arborists Association and Maine Nurserymen Association.

During the 1930s, 1940s and 1950s, Mr. McSherry was the tree warden for Fryeburg and surrounding towns. When Dutch elm disease struck he worked for several years in each town removing and replanting trees.

In 1963 he founded McSherry's Nursery in Center Conway, N.H.

He was a longtime member of the Fryeburg Kiwanis Club and the Pythagorean Lodge of Masons.

His wife, the former Dorothy Hall, died in 1996.

A granddaughter, Katherine McSherry, died in 1992.

Surviving are his daughter, Gail McSherry of Fryeburg; two sons, John and Ned, both of Fryeburg; four grandchildren, Paige Fox, Bethany Higdon and Stephanie and Lizzy McSherry, all of Fryeburg; and two great-grandchildren.

A funeral service will be held at 4 p.m. Saturday at the Church of New Jerusalem on Oxford Street. Arrangements are by Wood Funeral Home.

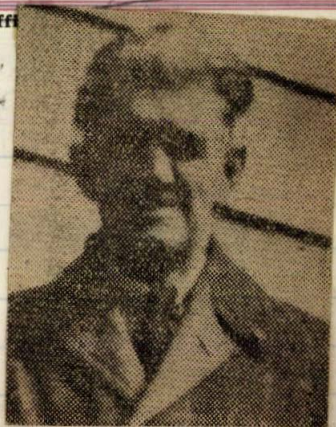
